FLOOD/WEATHER ADVISORY

According to the latest Hydro-Meteorological prevailing conditions, Moderate to strong Monsoon currents interacting with westerly wave are affecting the upper catchments of all the major Rivers along with upper catchments of river Kabul and associated Nullahs / Tributaries. Under the influence of this weather system, rivers situation during next 72-hours is likely to remain as under:

- Medium to High level flows are expected in the River Jhelum & Chenab and Medium Level flows are also expected in River Kabul and Indus.
- Medium to High level flows are expected in the Nullahs of Rivers Chenab & Ravi along with Hill Torrents of DG Khan Division.
- **Urban Flooding is also likely in Peshawar, Rawalpindi, Faisalabad, Gujranwala, Lahore & Sargodha Divisions.**

All the concerned authorities are requested to keep themselves abreast of latest flood forecast/ updates and take precautionary measures during the forecast period.
