Subject: Precautionary Measures Against Out Break of Noval Carona Virus

Reference: Above subject.

- 2. Recent outbreak of Noval Carona Virus has caused massive catastrophe in China. So far, Noval Carona Virus has plagued more than 20 countries and its detection is being reported in US, Australia, Canada, France, Germany and even in India. China and other Global Health Organizations are still struggling to control further outbreak of Noval Carona Virus.
- 3. Ministry of National Health Service Regulation & Coordination of Pakistan has issued advisory and precautionary measure to control the outbreak of Noval Carona Virus in Pakistan. The advisory explains that the first and immediate treatment against the disese is wearing of face mask and gloves, both by the patient and the handler. Noval Carona Virus is viral disease, and this immediate first step can control its further outbreak.
- 4. Forgoing in view, in order to deny / curtail the outbreak of Noval Carona Virus in Pakistan, availability of sufficient quantity of first aid material (face mask & gloves) should be ensured at all tiers of health units. Therefore, it is requested that export of N95 face mask (face mask) and hand gloves (disposable) outside Pakistan from land, air and sea routes be banned forthwith and till further advise. These steps are taken as a first precautionary measure and to confirm the availability of sufficient basic first aid material in Pakistan.

5. All concerned are requested to adhere the instructions and ensuring implementation.
