**DAILY WEATHER REPORT FOR MEDIA**  
**(Issued on Thursday June 02, 2016 at 1900 PST)**

1. **Synoptic Situation.** A western disturbance is affecting upper parts of the country and is likely to persist till Friday.
2. **Weather next 24 hrs.** More rain-thunderstorm accompanied by strong gusty winds/duststorm (with few hailstorms) is expected at scattered places in KP (Malakand, Hazara, Peshawar, Kohat, Mardan, Bannu division), upper Punjab (Rawalpindi, Sargodha, Gujranwala, Lahore, Faisalabad, Sahiwal divisions), Islamabad, FATA, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir, while at few places in Quetta, Zhob, D.G.Khan. D.I.Khan and Multan divisions. Hot and dry weather elsewhere in the country.
3. **Weather Outlook for Next 48 hrs.** Rain-thunderstorm accompanied by strong gusty winds / duststorm (with few hailstorms) is expected at isolated places in KP (Malakand, Hazara, Peshawar, Kohat, Mardan, Bannu division), upper Punjab (Rawalpindi, Sargodha, Gujranwala, Lahore, Faisalabad, Sahiwal divisions), Islamabad, FATA, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir. Hot and dry weather elsewhere in the country.
4. **Weather Warning.** Nil.
5. **Past Weather.** Rain-thunderstorm/duststorm occurred at scattered places in Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha, Peshawar, Malakand, Hazara divisions, Islamabad, FATA and Kashmir. Weather remained hot and dry elsewhere in the country.
