Subject: GLOF ALERT

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) vide their ALERT has forecasted that a strong weather system is likely to produce mix of snowfall and rainfall in Kashmir and Gilgit-Baltistan from 21-23 September 2015. Heavy snowfall is expected over the mountains higher than 15000ft and rainfall in valleys. Rain may trigger GLOF and flash floods from glacier origins. Probability of such events is greater in Baltistan. The communities living along the rivers and streams should exercise extreme care during the next 5-days.

- 2. In view of above, it is requested that all concerned should be cautioned / forewarned to take all necessary precautionary measures to avoid any loss of lives and damage to public as well as private property.
