Subject: **GLOF Alert**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) vide their advisory dated 19 August 2015 has predicted that air temperature in Gilgit-Baltistan and Chitral is expected to increase by 2-4°C during next three days due to relatively clearer skies. Afterward, light to moderate rain is also expected at isolated places. As a result, melt rate will enhance which is likely to trigger GLOF/flash flood events in Bagrot, Shigar, Skardu, Khaploo, Ghanchey and valleys of chitral district in KP.

2. In view of above, it is requested that all concerned should be cautioned / forewarned to take all necessary precautionary measures to avoid any loss of lives and damage to public as well as private property.
