MORE RAINS PREDICTED IN COMING DAYS

Meteorological Office predicted that fresh westerly weather system is likely to enter Baluchistan on Wednesday evening/night and likely to spread over KP, FATA and Punjab on Thursday. Under the influence of this weather system, the weather forecast for coming days is:-

- Scattered rain thundershowers are expected in Baluchistan on Thursday and Friday.
- b. Widespread rains thundershower (with isolated heavy falls) is expected in FATA, KP and Kashmir from Thursday to Saturday.
- c. Scattered rain thundershower in Islamabad, upper Punjab (Rawalpindi, Sargodha, Gujranwala, Lahore and Faisalabad divisions) during the Thursday evening/night to Sunday.
- d. Isolated rain thunderstorm is also expected in south Punjab (Bahawalpur, Multan, D.G. Khan) upper Sindh (Sukkur and Larkana) on Thursday night to Friday.

Note

- Rain / thundershowers in upper Punjab & KP may be accompanied by isolated hailstorm.
- During rains, there will be high risk of land sliding in the vulnerable areas of in
 Malakand, Hazara division and Kashmir on Friday/Saturday.
