**Press Release****COLD WAVE CONDITIONS IN THE COUNTRY LIKELY TO CONTINUE IN NEXT 3-4 DAYS**

Metrological Office predicted that the wet spell of rain/snowfall over upper parts of the Country has subsided. Due to recent heavy snowfall over the hills of northern areas, upper KP, Galliyat and Kashmir, cold wave has griped most parts of the Country.

- a. The night temperatures in most parts of the northern areas, upper KP, Murree, Kashmir and north Balochistan have fallen below zero point.
- b. The current cold wave conditions are likely to prevail in most parts of the Country during next 3-4 days. The night temperature in most parts of the Country may further fall upto 04°C.
- c. Some of the plain areas of KP and Punjab may experience frost during the period.
- d. Due to cold air, the night temperature in Karachi and coastal areas are also expected to fall during next 2-3 days.
