Subject: **SIGNIFICANT FLOOD FORECAST FOR RIVER INDUS AT KALABAGH AND CHASHMA**

According to latest Meteorological & Hydrological conditions observed by Flood Forecasting Division Lahore, River Indus at Kalabagh is likely to attain medium to high flood level ranging between 460000 cusecs to 520000 cusecs during the period from 1600 PST of 18th July 2015 to 1600 PST of 19th July 2015.

2. River Indus at Chashma is also likely to attain medium to high flood level ranging between 460000 cusecs to 520000 cusecs during the period from 2300 PST of 18th July 2015 to 2300 PST of 19th July 2015.

3. In view of above, it is requested that all concerned should be cautioned / forewarned to take all necessary precautionary measures to avoid any loss of lives and damage to public as well as private property.
