Subject: **WIDESPREAD RAINS PREDICTED IN THE COUNTRY DURING SUNDAY TO THURSDAY**

As per Pakistan Meteorological Department Press Release strong Monsoon Currents are likely to penetrate in upper parts of Pakistan during next 3-4 days that may interact with westerly wave over upper Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa (Malaknd, Hazara, Mardan, and Peshawar divisions), Upper FATA (Baujor, Mahmond, Khyber, Orakzai and Kurram Agencies), Upper Punjab (Rawalpindi, Sargodha, Gujranwala and Lahore divisions) and Kashmir from Sunday to Tuesday. Widespread rains with scattered heavy at times very heavy falls over the areas are expected during the period.

2. Strong Monsoon Currents are likely to penetrate in southern parts of the country from Monday to Thursday. Widespread rains with scattered heavy at times very heavy falls in Sindh (Sukkar, Larkana, Karachi, Hyderabad and Mirpur Khas divisions), Southern Punjab (D.G.Khan, Multan and Bahawalpur divisions), Eastern Balochistan (Zhob, Sibbi and Nasirabad divisions) and Southern KP (D.I. Khan division) during Monday to Thursday.

3. Heavy rains may generate flash flooding and urban flooding in the vulnerable area.

4. In view of above, it is requested that all concerned should take **necessary measures to avoid loss of life and damage to property.**
