**WEATHER OUTLOOK**

**SYNOPTIC SITUATION.** Seasonal low pressure area lies over southeast Iran with its trough extending south east wards. A westerly wave is affecting upper parts of the country and likely to persists till Saturday. The same weather system will affect northern parts and its adjoining areas till Sunday.

<b><u>DAYS / DATE</u></b>	<b><u>WEATHER OUTLOOK</u></b>
THURSDAY 02-06-2016	Rain-thunderstorm with strong gusty winds is expected at scattered places in KP, FATA, Quetta, Zhob, Rawalpindi, Sargodha, Gujranwala divisions, Islamabad, Kashmir and Gilgit-Baltistan. Hot and dry weather is expected in other parts of the Country.
FRIDAY 03-06-2016	Rain-thunderstorm with strong gusty winds is expected at few places in KP, FATA, Quetta, Zhob, Rawalpindi, Sargodha, Gujranwala divisions, Islamabad, Kashmir and Gilgit-Baltistan. Hot and dry weather is expected in other parts of the Country.
SATURDAY 04-06-2016	Hot and dry weather is expected in most parts of the Country. However, rain-thunderstorm is expected at few places in Malakand division, Kashmir and Gilgit-Baltistan.
SUNDAY 05-06-2016	Hot and dry weather is expected in most parts of the Country. However, rain-thunderstorm is expected at few places in Malakand division, Kashmir and Gilgit-Baltistan.
MONDAY 06-06-2016	Very hot and dry weather is expected in most parts of the Country.
TUESDAY 07-06-2016	Very hot and dry weather is expected in most parts of the Country.
WEDNESDAY 08-06-2016	Very hot and dry weather is expected in most parts of the Country.
SIGNIFICANT WEATHER (IF ANY)	Very hot weather conditions would continue in South Punjab, Upper Sindh and its adjoining areas. Due to heating, some dust storm are also likely in these areas during the period.

1. **Synoptic Situation.** A western disturbance is affecting upper parts of the country and is likely to persist till Friday.
2. **Weather next 24 hrs.** More dust-thunder-storm rain is expected at scattered places in KP (Malakand, Hazara, Peshawar, Kohat, Mardan, Bannu division), Upper Punjab (Rawalpindi, Sargodha, Gujranwala, Lahore, Faisalabad divisions), Islamabad, FATA, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir while at few places in D.G.Khan. D.I.Khan, Quetta, Zhob and Multan divisions during (evening /night). Hot & Dry weather is expected in other parts of the country.
3. **Weather Outlook for Next 48 hrs.** Rain-thunderstorm with strong gusty winds is expected at different places in Malakand, Hazara, Peshawar, Kohat, Mardan, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha Zhob divisions, Islamabad, FATA, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir. Hot & Dry weather is expected in other parts of the country.
4. **Weather Warning.** Nil.
5. **Past Weather.** Dust-thunder-storm rain is occurred at scattered places in Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha, Peshawar, Malakand, Hazara divisions, Islamabad and Kashmir. Weather remained dry in other parts of the country.
