**MONSOON 2018 DAILY SITUATION REPORT NO – 032**

**(PERIOD COVERED: 1300 HRS 25 July 2018 – 1300 HRS 26 July 2018)**

1. **Rivers Flow Situation Reported by Flood Forecasting Division.** River Kabul at Nowshera is in Low Flood level. All the other major Rivers are in the state of their normal flows.

***Low to Medium level flooding is expected in the Nullahs of Rivers Ravi and Chenab. Urban Flooding is also expected in Lahore, Gujranwala, Faisalabad and Sargodha Divisions during next 72 hours.*** Details at Annex A.

2. **Past Meteorological Situation and Future Forecast by PMD.** Significant rainfall reported during last 24 hours: Brarkot 92 mm, Rawalakot 80 mm, Murree 76 mm, Shamsabad 77 mm, Sialkot 66 mm, Kallar 57 mm, Jhelum 44 mm, Mangla 43 mm, Sehrkikota 43 mm, Rashidabad (Kalpani) 42 mm and Hajira 40 mm . PMD forecast for next 24 hours predicts ***“Scattered wind thunderstorm / rain with isolated moderate to heavy falls and one or two very heavy falls are expected over Sargodha, Lahore, Gujranwala, & Faisalabad Divisions. Scattered thunderstorm / rain with moderate to heavy falls at isolated places are expected over the Upper Catchments of all the major Rivers along with Malakand, Hazara, Peshawar, D.I. Khan, Kohat, Rawalpindi and D.G. Khan Divisions. Isolated thunderstorm / rain is expected over Balochistan Division & Northeast Balochistan.”*** ***Wet spell is likely to continue.***

4. **Significant Events Last 24 Hours**

a. **Azad Jammu & Kashmir**

- (1) On 24 July 2018, due to heavy rains 3 x injured, 1 x house partially damaged and 1 x house fully damaged were reported in District Sudhnoti.
- (2) On 25 July 2018, due to cloud burst, flash flood was reported in Nakot Area, Tehsil Leepa, District Jhelum Valley resulting 17 x house fully damaged and 22 shops damaged.
- (3) On 25 July 2017, due to sudden increase in local stream, District Rawalakot, 1 x child was drowned. Dead body has been recovered.

b. **Gilgit Baltistan**. On 25 July 2018, flash flooding / landslide was reported in Gilgit Baltistan at following locations:-

- (1) On Astore road at Bulan, the blockage was cleared and opened for traffic by district administration. However, no loss of life or injured was reported.
- (2) In CMH Gamba Area, District Skardu, 50 x houses were vacated due to high risk. However, no loss of life or injured was reported.
- (3) In District Skardu, flash flood damaged 2 x link bridges between Skardu and Chanda & Tandal Valleys.
- (4) In Mayordu Nullah, District Karmang resulting 15 x houses partially damaged and few cattles were drowned in flash flood water. However, no other loss of life or injured was reported.

5. **Road Situation (NHA and Respective Provinces)**

a. Following roads are blocked in GB:-

- (1) Shimshal Valley Road at Phurjrik. Work is in progress to restore the road.
- (2) Road to Batswat village, Tehsil Ishkoman, District Ghizer. Work is in progress to restore the road by district administration. However, alternate route has been provided for small traffic through Tishnalote.

b. All other roads across the Country are clear.

6. **Railway Situation**. All railway routes are clear.

7. **Preliminary Losses / Damages Reported**.

a. **During Last 24 Hours**. 1 x Death, 3 x Injured and 34 x houses damaged in AJ&K and GB.

b. Overall details of losses / damages during Monsoon Season 2018 are at **Annex C**.

8. **Relief Provided**. Overall details of relief provided at **Annex D**.

9. **Any Critical Activity to Report**. Nothing to Report.

10. **NDMA Recommendations**. In view of ongoing Monsoon spell and considering the weather forecast by PMD, relevant stakeholders are advised to remain on **Alert** and ensure following:-

a. **Timely clearance of sewerage / drainage system in all major cities including Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha, Faisalabad, Lahore, Multan & Peshawar by all stakeholders.**

b. Issuing Alert to people residing in / close to river plains / water courses.

c. Raising awareness to public with regards to vacating dangerous buildings, remaining away from electric wires and avoid swimming during rain especially in underpasses.

d. Advising vulnerable population not to venture Nullahs crossing/ likely flash flooding routes.

e. **PDMA Punjab Only. Considering possibility of rains in D.G Khan Division, vulnerable communities especially along hill torrents be sensitised for requisite precautionary measures.**

f. NHA, FWO and C&W Department of respective Provinces / Regions may please remain ready for restoring road linkages.

g. NIH / NHEPRN to advise all provincial Health departments about pre-placement of necessary staff and medicines where required.

**PAST METEOROLOGICAL SITUATION AND FUTURE FORECAST BY PMD**

1. **Significant Rainfall Reported Last 24 Hours**

- a. **Islamabad**. Shamsabad 77 mm, Old Airport 72 mm, Zero Point 55 mm, Golra 53 mm, Saidpur 32 mm, Bokra 29 mm and New Airport 22 mm.
- b. **Balochistan**. Khuzdar 8 mm.

2. **Weather Forecast Next 24 Hours**. Scattered wind thunderstorm / rain with isolated moderate to heavy falls and one or two very heavy falls are expected over Sargodha, Lahore, Gujranwala, & Faisalabad Divisions. Scattered thunderstorm / rain with moderate to heavy falls at isolated places are expected over the Upper Catchments of all the major Rivers along with Malakand, Hazara, Peshawar, D.I. Khan, Kohat, Rawalpindi and D.G. Khan Divisions. Isolated thunderstorm / rain is expected over Balochistan Division & Northeast Balochistan.

3. **Weather Outlook from 27 July 2018 to 28 July 2018**. **Wet spell is likely to continue.**

4. **Catchments Forecast**. No very heavy rainfall is expected over the Upper Catchments of all the major rivers.

5. **Weather Last 24 Hours**. Rain-thundershower with gusty winds occurred at scattered places in Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Lahore, Malakand, Hazara, Peshawar, Kohat Divisions and Kashmir, while at isolated places in Faisalabad Division and Gilgit-Baltistan. Weather remained hot and humid in other parts of the Country.
