MONSOON 2018 DAILY SITUATION REPORT NO – 006

(PERIOD COVERED: 1300 HRS 29 June 2018 – 1300 HRS 30 June 2018)

1. **Rivers Flow Situation Reported by Flood Forecasting Division.** River Kabul at Nowshera is in Low Flood level and all other major rivers are flowing at normal level. Details at **Annex A.**
2. **Past Meteorological Situation and Future Forecast by PMD.** Significant rainfall reported in last 24 hours: T.T. Singh 144 mm, Shorkot 103 mm, Marala 68 mm, Faisalabad 63 mm, Mandibahauddin 63 mm, Kasur 56 mm, Baranala 48 mm, Chhor 44 mm and Gujrat 43 mm. PMD forecast for next 24 hours predicts *Isolated thunderstorm/rain with one or two heavy falls is expected over Upper Catchments of Rivers Jhelum, Chenab, Ravi & Sutlej along with Faisalabad, Gujranwala, Lahore, Sahiwal, Bahawalpur, Malakand, Hazara & Rawalpindi Divisions, Southeast Sindh, Northeast Balochistan & Gilgit Baltistan.* Details at **Annex B.**

10. **NDMA Recommendations**

 - b. Issuing Alert to people residing in / close to river plains / water courses.
 - c. Raising awareness to public with regards to vacating dangerous buildings, remaining away from electric wires and avoid swimming during rain especially in underpasses.
 - d. Advising vulnerable population not to venture into nullahs / flash flooding routes.
 - e. NHA, FWO and C&W Depts of respective Provinces / Regions may please remain vigilant in restoring road linkages.
 - f. NIH / NHEPRN to advise all provincial Health departments about pre-placement of necessary staff and medicines where required.

 - c. **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa**. Saidu Sharif 22 mm, Chakothi 5 mm, Malamjabba 5 mm, Kalam 4 mm, Besham 3 mm, Bannu 1 mm and Kot Nainan 1 mm.
 - d. **Punjab**. T.T. Singh 144 mm, Shorkot 103 mm, Marala 68 mm, Faisalabad 63 mm, Mandibahauddin 63 mm, Kasur 56 mm, Baranala 48 mm, Gujrat 43 mm, Gujranwala 35 mm, Ravi Syphon 35 mm, Lahore 38 mm, Jhelum 30 mm, Sahiwal 27 mm, Sialkot 20 mm, Jhang 19 mm, Shadiwal 19 mm, Alexandra Bridge 18 mm, Mangla 7 mm, Bahawalnagar 5 mm, Sargodha 4 mm and Zafarwal 1 mm.

2. **Weather Forecast Next 24 Hours**. Isolated thunderstorm/rain with one or two heavy falls is expected over Upper Catchments of Rivers Jhelum, Chenab, Ravi & Sutlej along with Faisalabad, Gujranwala, Lahore, Sahiwal, Bahawalpur, Malakand, Hazara & Rawalpindi Divisions, Southeast Sindh, Northeast Balochistan & Gilgit Baltistan.
3. **Weather Outlook for 1 July 2018 and 2 July 2018**. Scattered wind thunderstorm/rain with isolated heavy falls is expected over Lahore, Faisalabad, Gujranwala, Rawalpindi, Sargodha & Sahiwal Divisions along with Upper Catchments of Rivers Jhelum, Chenab, Ravi & Sutlej from 2 July 2018.
4. **Weather Last 24 Hours**. Rain-thundershower with gusty winds occurred at scattered places in Gujranwala, Lahore, Faisalabad, Multan, D.G khan, Malakand, Hazara, Divisions, Gilgit-Baltistan, Kashmir while at isolated places in Mirpurkhas, Sukkur, Kalat, Makran, Bhawalpur, Rawalpindi Divisions.
