Subject: FLOOD ADVISORY - TRIBUTARIES OF RIVER KABUL, INDUS & JHELUM

According to the latest hydrometeorological conditions, a Strong Westerly wave is expected to approach the upper parts of the country tonight. This weather system is likely to significantly affect the Upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit-Baltistan & Kashmir, bringing widespread rainfall and associated weather activity. As a result, Flash Flood conditions may develop in the tributaries of the Rivers Kabul, Indus, and Jhelum. Close monitoring of these areas is advised due to the potential for rapid runoff and localized flooding. PDMAs, Irrigation Departments and respective district administration(s) / DDMA(s), municipal / city administration(s) of KP and Punjab are advised to ensure following: -

- a. Identification of vulnerable points / at-risk communities and devise mitigation and safety measures.
- Maintain enhanced alert level / monitoring of developing situation to reduce reaction / response times.
- c. All civic agencies / rescue services (Rescue 1122 / Fire Brigade / Ambulance / Civil Defence) to remain alert and ensure availability of personnel and equipment during the mentioned period, especially in at-risk areas.
- d. People living along the River Kabul, Indus & Jhelum and their associated

 Tributaries / Nullahs to be sensitized about expected increase of water flows.
- e. Timely evacuation of at-risk population from low-lying / flood prone areas as per Evacuation Plans and ensure availability of shelter, food and medicines in those shelter camps.
- f. Locals / farmers / cattle herders be **forewarned to shift cattle away from low**lying areas adjacent to Rivers and their associated Tributaries / Nullahs.
- g. Restrict vehicle movement in **low lying / at-risk areas**, close to Rivers and its associated water channels, tributaries / nullahs.
- h. Provision of POL for back-up generators at water pumping stations and timely pre-placement of de-watering equipment for de-flooding.
- DISCOs and relevant local administration / departments to ensure that necessary arrangements are undertaken to avoid electrocution incidents and timely restoration of power supply.

- j. Coordinate with concerned departments for clearance of roads in case of any blockage / obstruction, waterlogging and pre-placing of necessary emergency equipment at vulnerable / appropriate locations.
- k. Travelers and tourists are forewarned about risks posed at flood vulnerable locations and may be diverted to safe lay-by / waiting areas with sufficient supply of water / food and essential medicines in case of adverse / dangerous road conditions by Police, NH&MP and Local Administrations.
- In case of any eventuality, Special SITREP / Update be shared immediately with NDMA.
- 2. <u>Flash Flood Alert</u>. Flood Forecasting Division(FFD) Flash flood alert for River Kabul, Indus & Jhelum is enclosed as *Annex-A*.
- 3. <u>Flood Forecasting Division Only</u>. Please share regular updates on water flows on major rivers, <u>especially River Kabul, Indus & Jhelum every 3 hours</u> with NDMA.
- 4. <u>Press Information Department Only</u>. With the request for <u>wider circulation and public awareness</u>.
