

## Rainfall/ Thunderstorms Advisory (1st to 7th of May, 2025)



**Affected Areas:** Northern, central and southern regions of country.

**Hazard type:** Isolated heavy rainfall/ Isolated hailstorm

**Intensity:** Moderate to Heavy **Duration:** 1<sup>st</sup> May to 7<sup>th</sup> May, 2025

## **Weather Summary**

Unstable weather is expected starting May 1st to 7th, 2025, due to the moisture coming from the Bay of Bengal and the Arabian Sea, combined with rising temperatures and humidity. During this period, moderate to heavy rainfall, windstorms, thunderstorms, lightning, and isolated hailstorms are likely to occur across Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KP), Gilgit-Baltistan (GB), Azad Jammu and Kashmir (AJK), Upper and central Punjab, northern Balochistan, and northern and southern Sindh, with occasional breaks.

## **Weather Impacts**

Low-lying areas are likely to experience waterlogging, while steep terrains face a risk of landslides. Critical infrastructure, including roads and drainage systems, may be overwhelmed, disrupting transportation and essential services.
