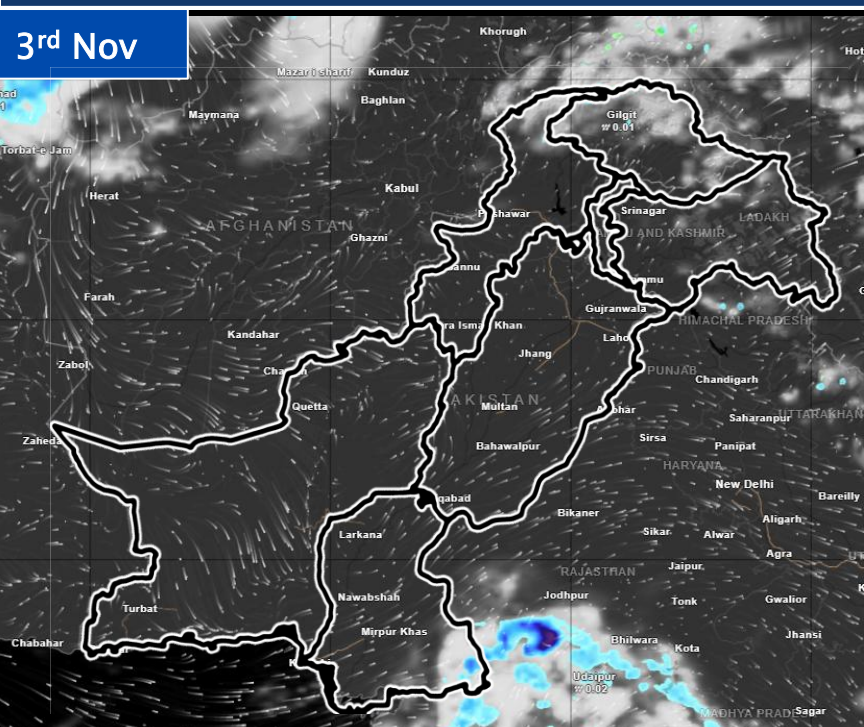




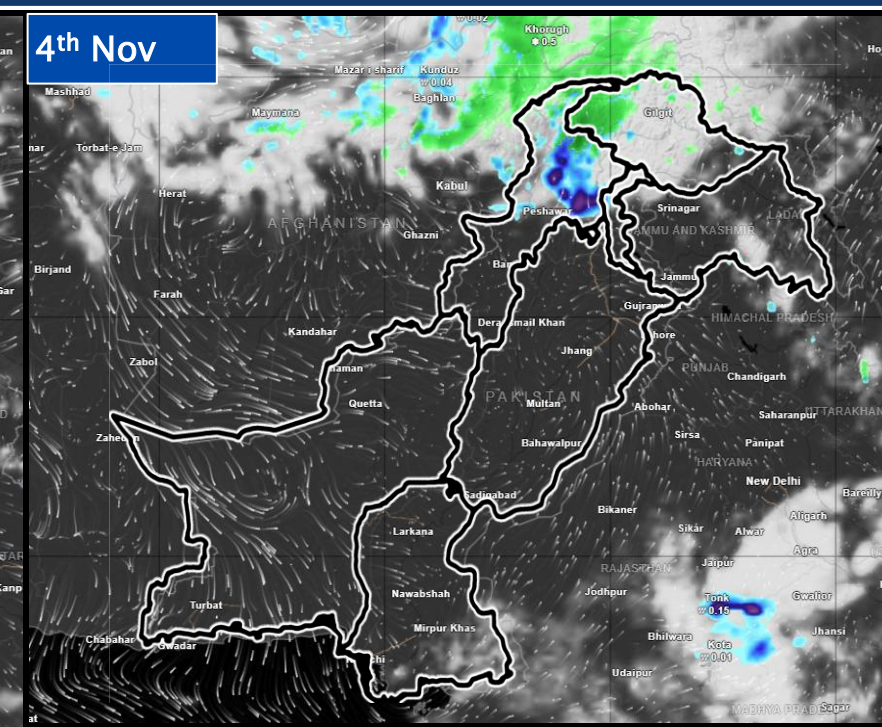
# Weather Advisory (3<sup>rd</sup> Nov to 8<sup>th</sup> Nov, 2025)

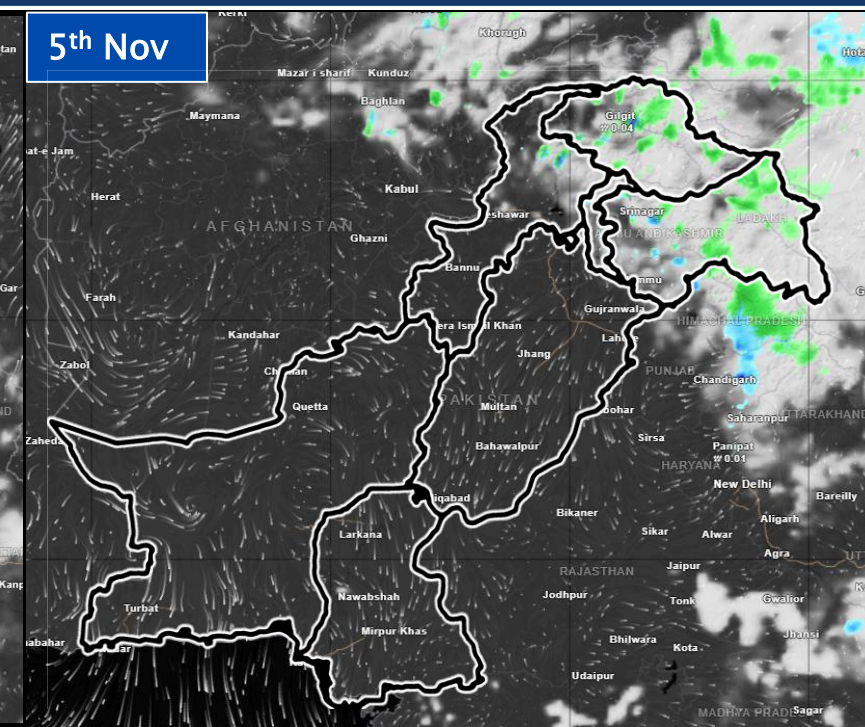

Continental air prevails over most of Pakistan with mainly dry, cool weather, while an approaching **westerly wave** may bring partly cloudy skies and light rain/snow over upper areas.

## Punjab

Dry weather conditions are expected with smog/fog to prevail over plain areas from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> November, 2025.

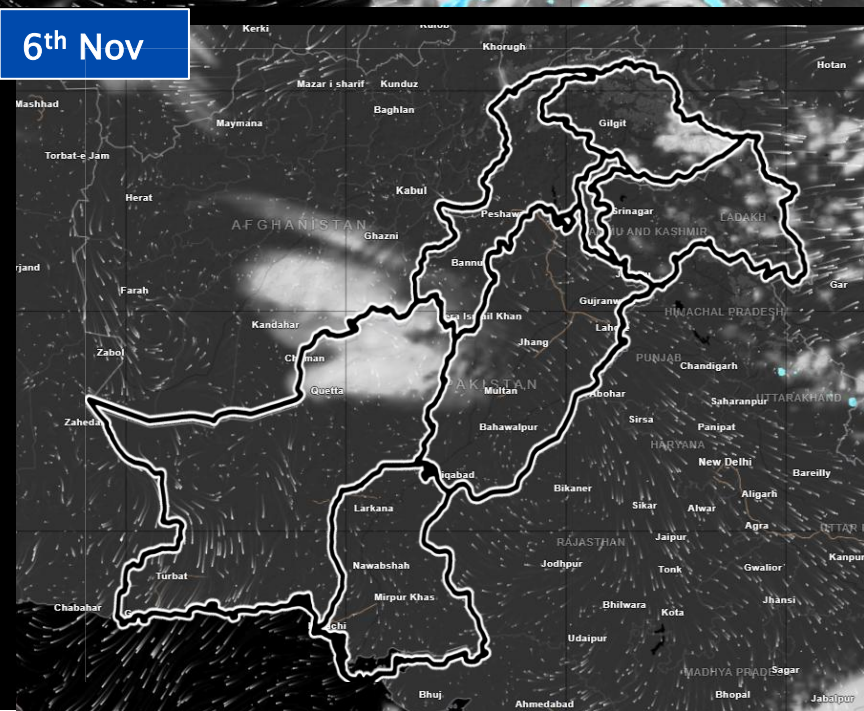
## Balochistan

Dry weather conditions are expected in the province from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> November, 2025 with cloudy weather in upper parts on November 6<sup>th</sup>.

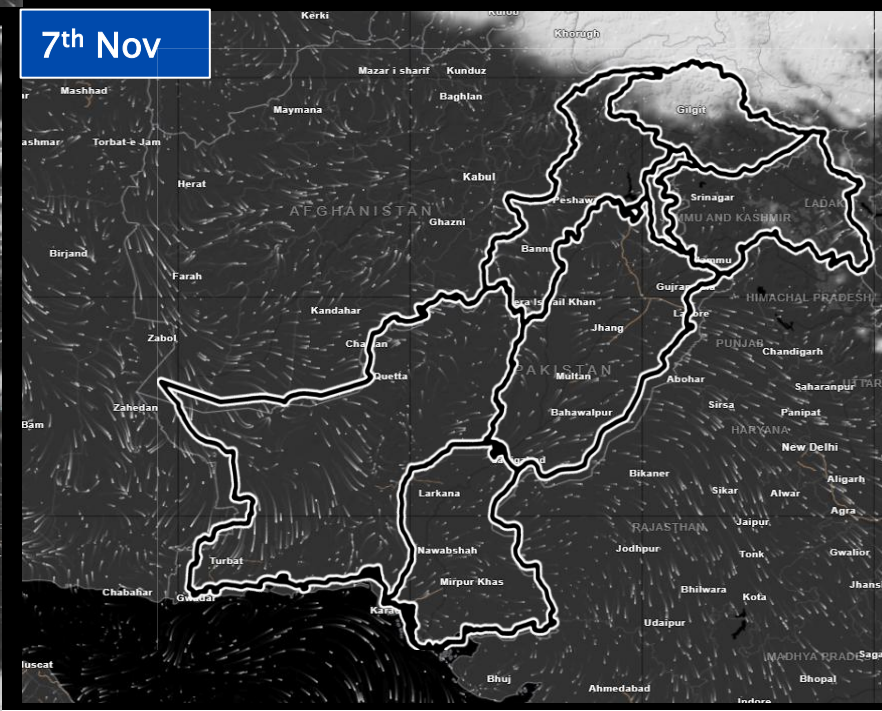
## Sindh

Dry weather conditions are expected in the province from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> November, 2025.

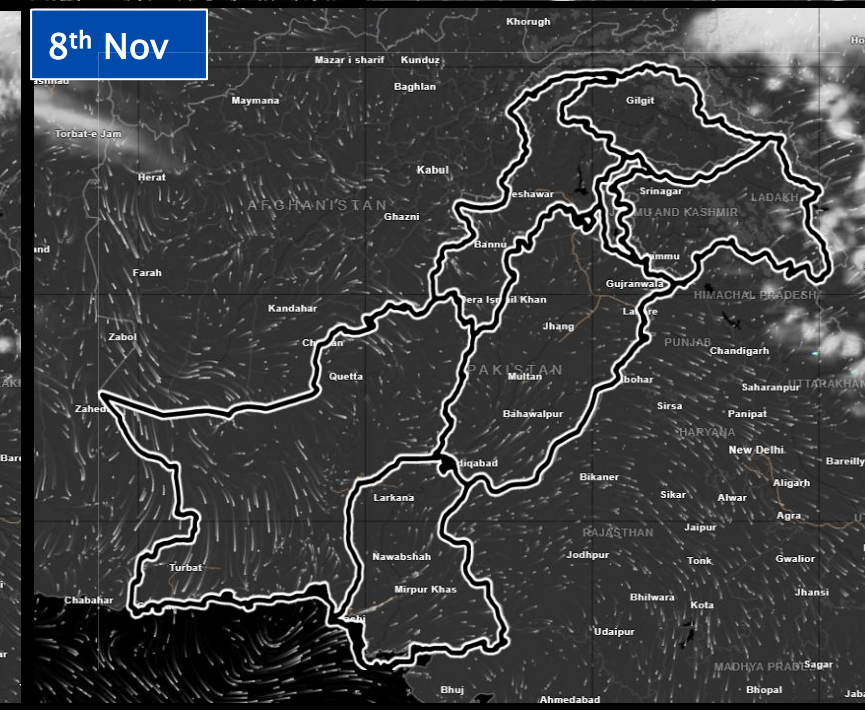

## KP

Mostly dry weather is likely across the province; however, light rain, thunderstorms, or snowfall may occur in upper areas including Chitral, Dir, Malakand, Abbottabad, Mansehra, and nearby regions from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> November 2025.

## GB & AJK

Partly cloudy and cold weather is expected in GB & AJK, with chances of isolated rain or snowfall in hilly areas including Astore, Skardu, Hunza, Bagh, Neelum Valley, and Muzaffarabad from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> November 2025.
