LoA with Pakistan Boy Scouts Association (PBSA)

NDMA's Think-Tank National Insitute of Disaster Managment (NIDM) signed Letter of Agreement (LoA) with Pakistan Boy Scouts Association (PBSA). Both organizations agreed to launch DRR Badge for Boy Scouts that will be linked with training by NIDM and selected practical activities. NIDM-PBSA agreed on long term cooperation to engage volunteers for community based disaster risk reduction and mitigation activities.

NDMA Dispatched Humaintarian Aid Assistance to Gaza 03-08-2025



Under the patronage of GoP, NDMA arranged a chartered flight carrying 100 tons of humanitarian aid to Gaza, Palestine, via Amman, Jordan. The flight departed from Islamabad International Airport on 4 Aug. The relief included 65 tons of canned food, 20 tons of dry/infant milk, 5 tons of biscuits, and 10 tons of medicines. This marked Pakistan's 17th consignment, bringing total aid to 1,715 tons. Pakistan stands in solidarity with the people of Gaza during this crisis.

Pakistan Dispatches Humanitarian Aid to Gaza under PM's Special Directives 10-08-2025



On the special instructions of the Prime Minister, Pakistan dispatched an additional 100 tons of relief goods for Gaza. Federal Minister for Information, Attaullah Tarar, attended the departure ceremony as the chief guest.

In this 18th consignment, 100 tons of relief goods including ration bags, ready-to-eat meals, and medicines was dispatched which was delivered to the people of Gaza via Oman and Jordan.

So far, Pakistan has sent a total of 1,815 tons of aid through 18 consignments. Pakistan stands with the people of Palestine in this difficult time and will make every possible effort to meet their needs.


NDMA Handed Over Pakistan School Safety Framework to Education Departments for Nationwide Implementation 13-08-2025



National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) formally handed over the Pakistan School Safety Framework (PSSF) to Federal and Provincial Education Departments during a high-level meeting at NDMA Headquarters. The session was chaired by Member Disaster Risk Reduction NDMA, Mr. Muhammad Idrees Mahsud.

During the meeting, NDMA officially handed over the PSSF for localized adoption and agreed on a comprehensive technical and monitoring mechanism to ensure its nationwide implementation. It was decided that Technical Working Group jointly headed by NDMA and MoFE&PT with representation from PDMAs and Provincial Education Departments will monitor the implementation. The group will also jointly vet and map activities of humanitarian partners, ensuring alignment with PSSF, avoiding duplication, and integrating with the post-2022 floods disaster risk reduction and climate resilience coordination mechanisms.

NDMA handed over relief supplies to the affected people of Buner 18-08-2025



As per the Prime Minister's instructions, NDMA continues dispatching relief goods for the flood-affected people of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

NDMA handed over relief supplies to the district administration for distribution among the affected people of Buner.

Federal Minister Engineer Amir Muqam attended the handover ceremony. The consignment dispatched this morning for Buner included tents, blankets, a 7KVA generator, dewatering pumps, ration bags, and medicines.

NDMA remained full coordination with all relevant civil and military institutions and is continuously monitoring the relief operations being carried out by all concerned agencies.

NDMA handed over relief supplies to the affected people of Swat and Shangla 18-08-2025

Two separate consignments were dispatched for Swat and Shangla. The relief goods include tents, blankets, a 7KVA generator, dewatering pumps, ration bags, and medicines.

The supplies was handed over to the respective district administrations for distribution among the flood-affected people.

NDMA, in coordination with the Armed Forces and welfare organizations, also dispatched relief goods for Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Gilgit-Baltistan.

NDMA remained in close coordination with all relevant civil and military institutions and is continuously monitoring the relief operations being carried out.

NDMA remained in full coordination with all relevant civil and military institutions and is continuously monitoring the relief operations being carried out.


Pakistan Dispatches Humanitarian Aid to Gaza under PM's Special Directives 23-08-2025



Under Prime Minister's directive, Pakistan National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) coordinated the dispatch of Alkhidmat Foundation's 100 tons of relief consignment through chartered flight. The relief consignment included flour, ready-to-eat meals, cooking oil, jam, and fruit cocktails. The consignment was dispatched from Allama Iqbal International Airport, Lahore, to Gaza via Al Arish, Egypt. This marked Pakistan's 19th aid consignment, totaling 1,915 tons for Gaza.

A send-off ceremony was held at the airport, attended by Malik Muhammad Ahmad Khan, Speaker of Punjab Assembly, NDMA and Alkhidmat officials.








PAK NDMA DISASTER ALERT APP
