


Two Active Tropical Cyclones in Australian Region



Valid: 29 December 2025 – 4 January 2026

Affected Areas

West Kimberley coast (Broome, Dampier Peninsula, Derby, Cape Leveque); Cocos (Keeling) Islands.

Hazard Types

Damaging winds (gusts 120–140 km/h), heavy rainfall/flash flooding, storm surge, rough seas.

Summary

Two tropical cyclones are active in the Australian region. Hayley, currently Category 1 and expected to intensify to Category 2, is tracking south-southeast toward the Dampier Peninsula with landfall likely 30–31 December, bringing destructive winds and heavy rain to the west Kimberley coast. Grant, Category 3, is moving west across the open Indian Ocean after passing the Cocos Islands and poses no threat to the Australian mainland.
