




## Extreme Rainfall in Thailand & Malaysia



Valid: Today 06:00 (10 hours ago) Until Today 18:00

### Affected Areas

The most affected areas include: Southern Thailand: Pattani, Yala, Narathiwat Bordering Malaysia: Kelantan (Kota Bharu area) and severely affected areas would be: Songkhla (Hat Yai), Phatthalung, Trang, Satun Northern Kedah & Perlis (Malaysia).

### Hazard Types

Flash flooding & urban flooding, River flooding/overflow, Landslides & mudflows, Coastal inundation & rough seas, Thunderstorms & lightning, Transport disruption.

### Hazard Summary

The moderate northeast monsoon prevails over the Gulf, the South and the Andaman Sea will strengthen with more rains and isolated heavy to very heavy rains in the lower South. The rather strong wind forces the waves in the lower Gulf up to be 2-3 m high and above 3 m high in thundershowers. In the upper Gulf, the waves are likely about 2 m high and above 2 m high in thundershowers. All ships in the Gulf and the Andaman Sea should proceed with caution and keep off thundershowers, small boats in the lower Gulf keep ashore during 14-16 Dec.
