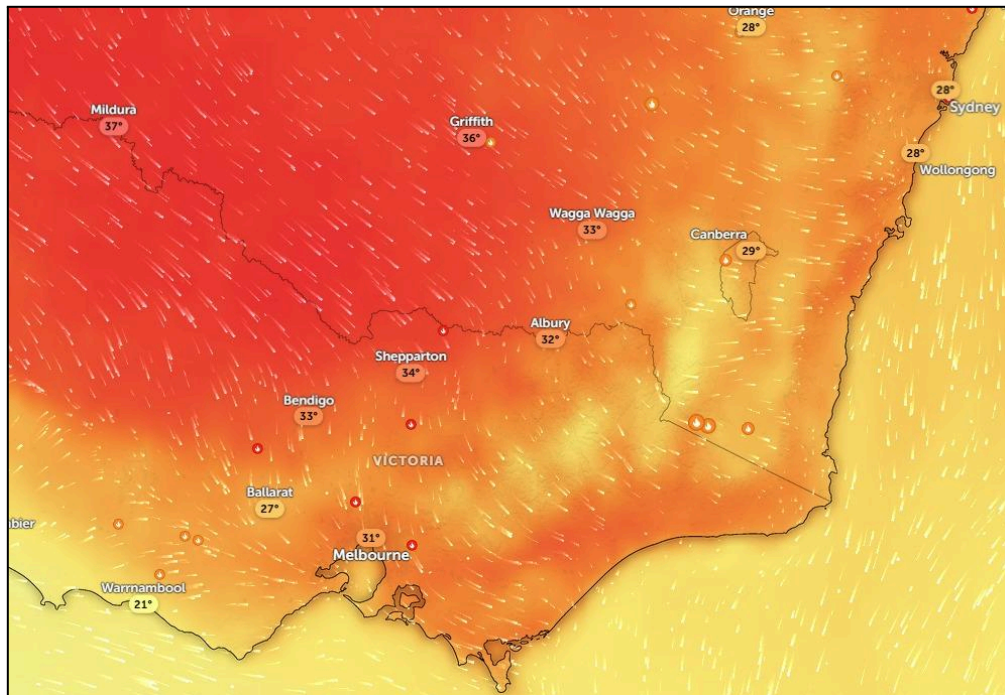




Active Fires in Australia

Northern and central Victoria, inland southern NSW (Mildura, Bendigo, Shepparton, Albury, Wagga Wagga, Griffith), Wimmera and West/South Gippsland districts.

Hazard Types

Heat stress, active fire

Hazard Summary

Hot to very hot conditions (mid-30s°C and above) combined with low humidity and north-westerly winds are generating extreme fire danger across much of Victoria and southern NSW. Active bushfires remain on the landscape, including contained incidents in forested areas where firefighting operations continue and smoke impacts may occur locally. Elevated temperatures and dry fuels may lead to rapid fire spread or new ignitions, increasing risk to communities, infrastructure, and transport routes. Wind shifts may also temporarily increase fire behaviour and unpredictability. Residents should remain alert, monitor official warnings, and review bushfire safety plans.
