




SEVERE COLD SPELL ALERT – ALASKA



Valid: February 13–18, 2026 (Peak: Feb 14–15)

Affected Areas

Southwest Alaska, Aleutians, Alaska Peninsula, Southcentral (including Anchorage), Interior, Bering Sea and northwest coasts.

Hazard Types

Heavy snow (4–12" total; locally higher), snowfall rates 0.1–0.5"/hr, gusty winds up to 80 km/h, blowing snow/blizzard conditions, reduced visibility, coastal surge risk, travel disruptions, possible power outages.

Hazard Summary

A strengthening low-pressure system off Alaska will pull Pacific moisture over cold Arctic air, producing a multi-day winter storm. Snow intensifies 14–15 February with banded heavy snowfall and strong winds. Conditions gradually ease after 16 February, but travel hazards may persist.
