

Weather Hazard Alert - West & Central Africa



Valid: For next 10 days (from 16th February to 25th February 2026)

Affected Areas

Coastal and adjoining inland areas of Ghana, Togo, Benin, southern Nigeria (including the Niger Delta), Cameroon, Equatorial Guinea, Gabon, and parts of Republic of the Congo and western Democratic Republic of the Congo.

Hazard Types

Severe Thunderstorms, Heavy to Intense Rainfall, Flash Flooding, Gusty to Damaging Winds, Frequent Lightning.

Hazard Summary

High atmospheric instability over the Gulf of Guinea and adjacent inland zones is supporting widespread thunderstorms. Repeated heavy downpours may trigger flash flooding in urban and low-lying coastal areas, with localized river rises inland. Strong convective winds and lightning are possible within the most intense storm clusters. Residents and authorities should remain alert, especially in flood-prone catchments and coastal cities.
