Hazard Summary

A tropical cyclone in the south-west Indian Ocean near Madagascar is forecast to bring severe weather to the island's eastern coast. Heavy rainfall is expected to cause riverine flooding and overland flow across low-lying coastal and river catchments, with an elevated risk of landslides in steep terrain. Damaging to destructive winds, storm surge, and dangerous seas may impact coastal communities, leading to power disruptions, road closures, and inundation of coastal infrastructure. Impacts may persist for several days as the system moves inland and rainfall continues.
