Subject: SIGNIFICANT FLOOD WARNING IN RIVER JHELUM AT MANGLA

Flood Forecasting Division (FFD) has forecasted that he latest Hydro-Meteorological Conditions over the Upper Catchments of River Jhelum, Exceptional High Flood ranging between 350000 to 450000 Cs is expected over Upstream at Mangla and it is also expected that the associated Nullahs of River Jhelum may attain High Level. *Flood Forecasting Division Warning No A-03/2025 dated 16 July 2025 attached as Annex-A*. All concerned Federal Ministries / Departments, PDMAs, Irrigation Departments, Respective District Administration(s) / DDMA(s), Municipal / City Administration(s) are advised to ensure following: -

- a. Identification of vulnerable points / at-risk communities and devise mitigation and safety measures.
- b. Maintain **enhanced alert level / monitoring** of developing situation to reduce reaction / response times.
- c. All civic agencies / rescue services (Rescue 1122 / Fire Brigade / Ambulance / Civil Defence) to remain alert and ensure availability of personnel and equipment during the next 48 hours, especially in at-risk areas.
- d. People living along the banks of River Jhelum and its associated Nullahs to be sensitized about expected increase of water flows.
- e. Timely evacuation of at-risk population from low-lying / flood prone areas as per Evacuation Plans and availability of shelter, food and medicines in those shelter camps.
- f. Locals / farmers / cattle herders be forewarned to shift cattle away from low
 lying areas adjacent to River Jhelum and its associated Nullahs.
- g. Restrict vehicle movement in **low lying / at-risk areas**, close to River Jhelum and its associated water channels / nullahs.
- h. Provision of POL for back-up generators at water pumping stations and timely pre-placement of de-watering equipment for de-flooding.
- DISCOs and relevant Local Administration / Departments to ensure that necessary arrangements are undertaken to avoid electrocution incidents and timely restoration of power supply.

- j. Provision of **relief / medical supplies to affectees** in timely manner.
- k. Coordinate with concerned departments for clearance of roads in case of any blockage / obstruction, waterlogging and pre-placing of necessary emergency equipment at vulnerable / appropriate locations.
- I. Travelers and Tourists are forewarned about risks posed at flood vulnerable locations and may be diverted to safe lay-by / waiting areas with sufficient supply of water / food and essential medicines in case of adverse / dangerous road conditions by Police, NH&MP and Local Administrations.
- m. In case of any eventuality, **Special SITREP / Update** be shared immediately with NDMA.

2. **Flood Forecasting Division Only**. Please share regular updates on water flows on major rivers, **especially River Jhelum every 3 hours** with NDMA.
