Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD), has issued a press release informing that a westerly wave is likely to enter Western Parts of the Country on Saturday, 5th March 2022 (night) and is likely to persist in Upper Parts of the country till Thursday, 10th March 2022. (Details enclosed at **Annex A)**. All Concerned PDMAs, SDMA, GBDMA and ICT administration is requested to ensure following precautionary measures to avoid any loss of life or property: -

- a. To coordinate with relevant District and Municipal Administrations and concerned departments (NHA, FWO and C&W) for restoration of roads in case of any blockage / obstruction / closures.
- b. To coordinate with relevant District and Municipal Administrations to ensure that any loose billboards and hoardings are secured from effects of thunderstorm / wind.
- To ensure pre-placement of necessary equipment and heavy machinery at all vulnerable and at-risk areas.
- d. To ensure that Tourists / Visitors in at-risk/ affected areas are apprised/ forewarned about weather forecast.
- e. To ensure availability of emergency services personnel.
- f. Daily updates will be shared with NDMA about the prevalent situation and in case of any emergency, regular/ hourly updates will be forwarded to NEOC. 2.

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has informed that, a westerly wave is likely to enter Western Parts of the Country on Saturday, 5th March 2022 (night) and is likely to persist in Upper Parts of the Country till Thursday 10th March 2022. Under the influence of this weather system:

Rain-wind/thunderstorm with snow over hills is expected in (Balochistan)
 Districts Quetta, Ziarat, Qila Saifullah, Pishin, Zhob, Musa Khel, (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa) Districts Waziristan, Dera Ismail khan, Bannu (Punjab) Districts

Bhakkar and Layyah from **Saturday**, **5**th **March 2022 (night) to Tuesday**, **8**th **March 2022**.

- Rain-wind / thunderstorms with isolated heavy falls / hailstorm expected in (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa) Districts Chitral, Dir, Swat, Malakand, Kohistan, Shangla, Buner, Manshera, Abbottabad, Haripur, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir from Saturday, 5th March 2022 (night) to Thursday, 10th March 2022 with occasional gaps.
- While, in (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa) Districts Swabi, Mardan, Nowshera, Charsadda, Peshawar, Bajaur, Kurram, Khyber, Kohat, Islamabad Capital Territory, (Punjab) Rawalpindi, Attock, Jhelum, Chakwal, Mianwali, Bhakkar, Sargodha, Khushab, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Lahore and Sialkot, on Sunday 6th March 2022 and Monday, 7th March 2022 (morning).
- Light with few moderate snowfalls is expected in (Punjab) Murree, (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa) Galliyat, Nathiagali, Naran, Kaghan, Dir, Swat, Shangla, Buner, (Kashmir) Neelum valley, Bagh, Haveli, (Gilgit Baltistan) Astore, Skardu and Hunza from Sunday 6th March 2022 till Thursday (10th March 2022).
