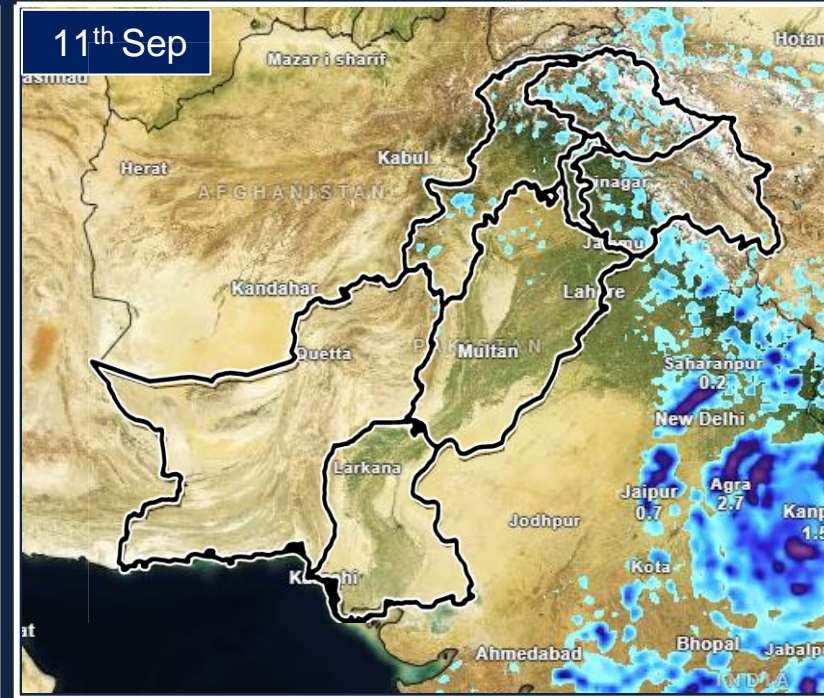
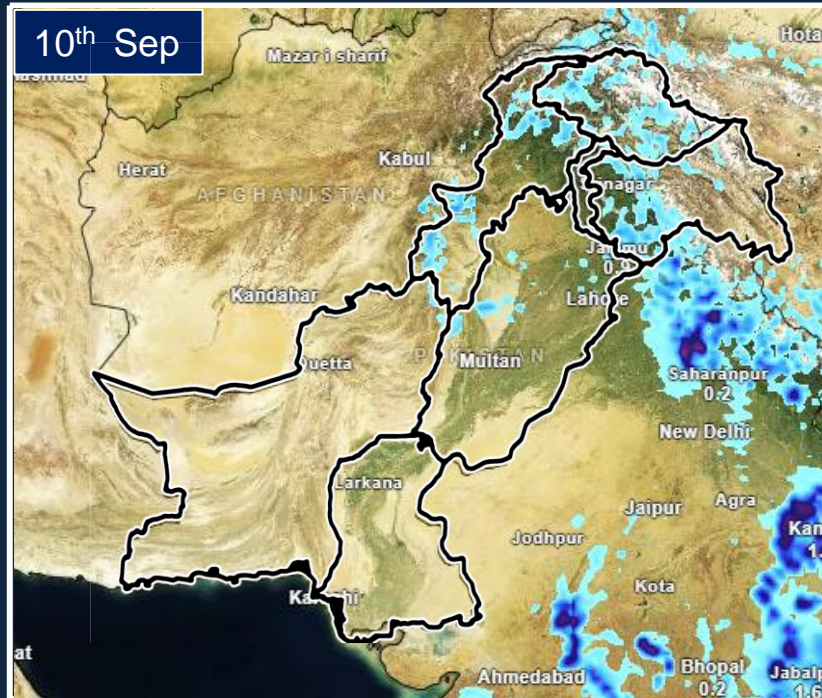
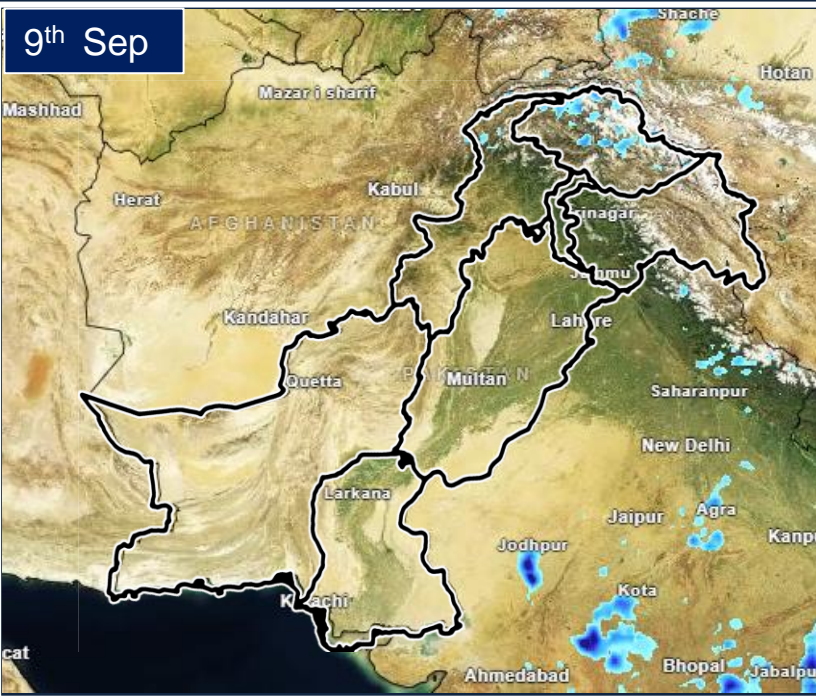




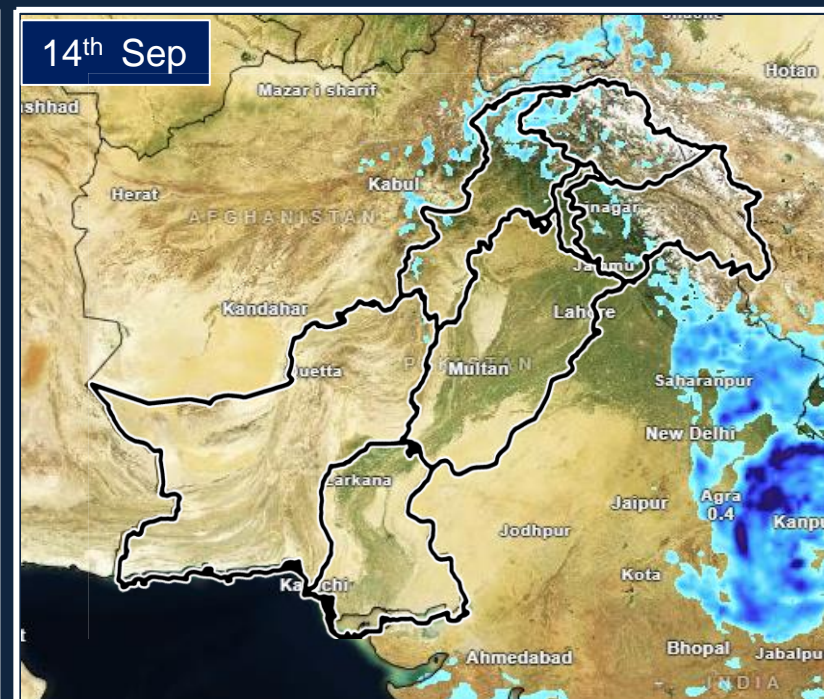
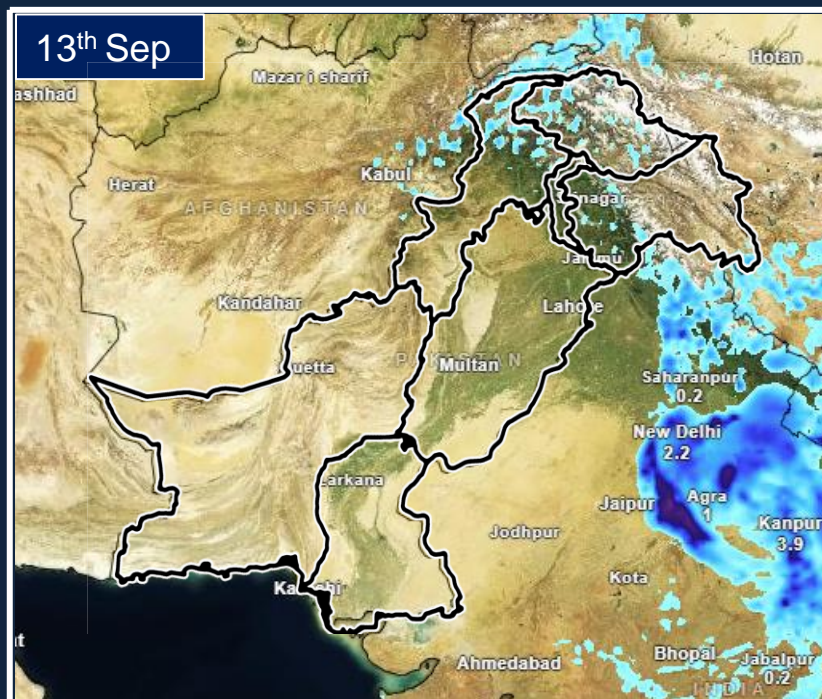
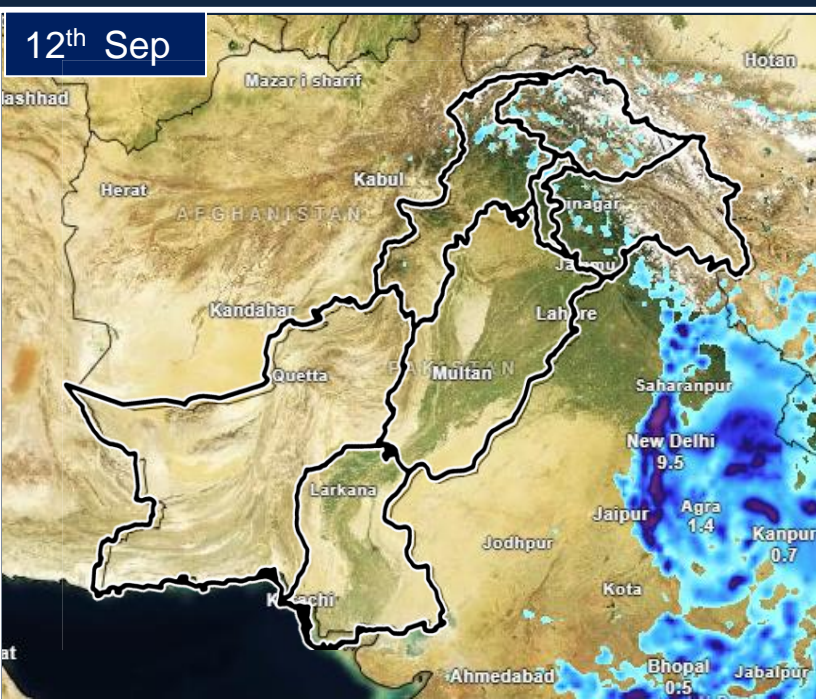
Weather Projection (9th to 14th September 2024)

KP:
 Dry weather is expected, with the possibility of isolated rain/thundershowers in KP, including Chitral, Dir, Peshawar, Swat, and surrounding areas from September 10th to 14th.

Punjab:
 Dry and hot weather is expected, with isolated rain/thundershowers anticipated in the Pothohar region on September 10th and 11th. Isolated rainfall/thundershowers are also expected in northeastern and southeastern parts of the province, including areas such as Attock, Bahawalnagar, Bahawalpur, Bhakkar, Chakwal, Chiniot, Dera Ghazi Khan, Faisalabad, Galliyat, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Hafizabad, Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Jhang, Jhelum, Kasur, Khanpur, Khushab, Lahore, Layyah, Mandi Bahauddin, Mianwali, Multan, Murree, Nankana Sahib, Narowal, Okara, Pakpattan, Rahim Yar Khan, Rajanpur, Sahiwal, Sargodha, Sheikhupura, Sialkot, Talagang, Toba Tek Singh, and Wazirabad during the period from September 12th to 14th.



Balochistan:
 Dry and Hot weather is expected, while thundershowers are expected in northern parts of the province, including Awaran, Barkhan, Harnai, Kalat, Khuzdar, Kohlu, Lasbella, Loralai, Naseerabad, Qila Abdullah, Qila Saifullah, Quetta, Sherani, Sibi, Ziarat, and Zhob during 14th September.

Sindh:
 Dry and Hot weather is expected all over the province.

AJ&K & GB:
 Cloudy weather, along with chances of isolated rainfall/thundershowers are expected in various parts of the province. However, some parts of Kashmir will also experience isolated rainfall during 10th to 14th September.
