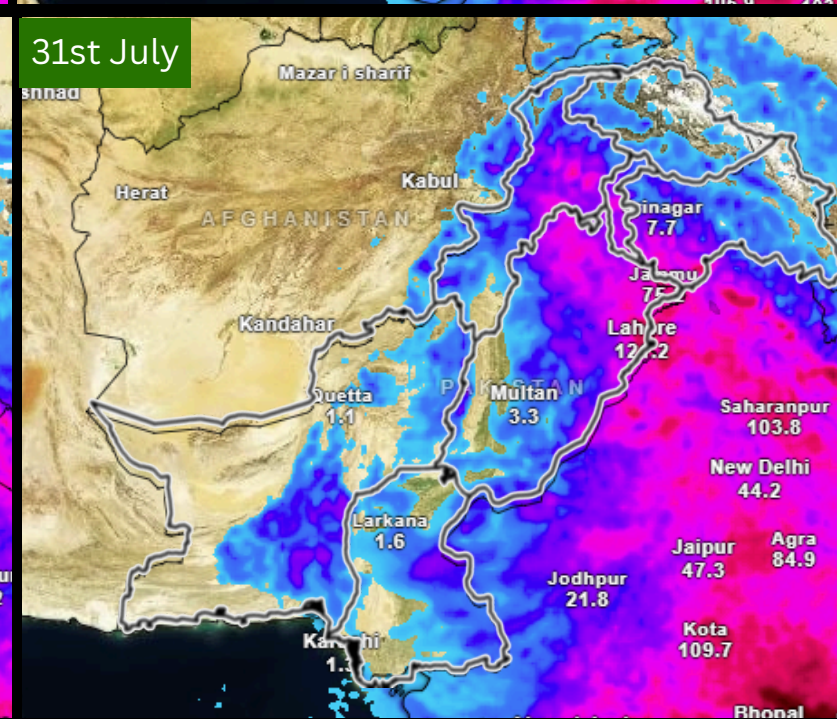
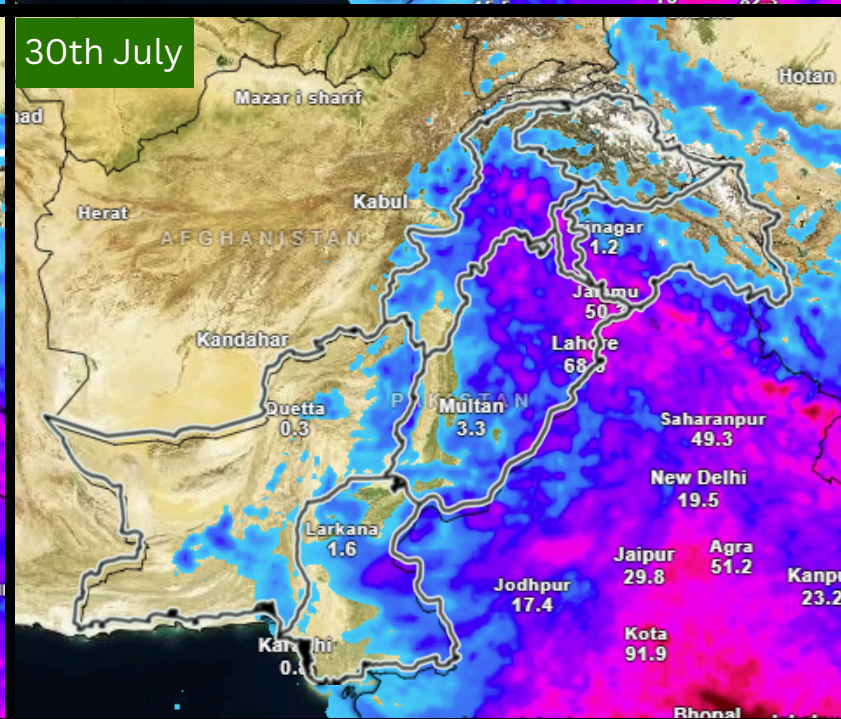
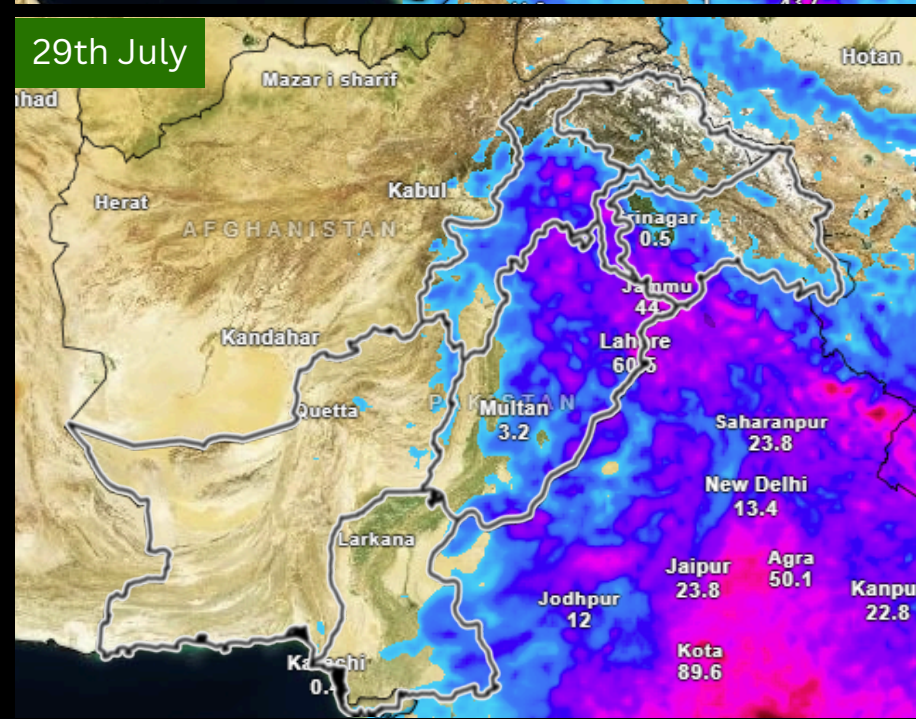
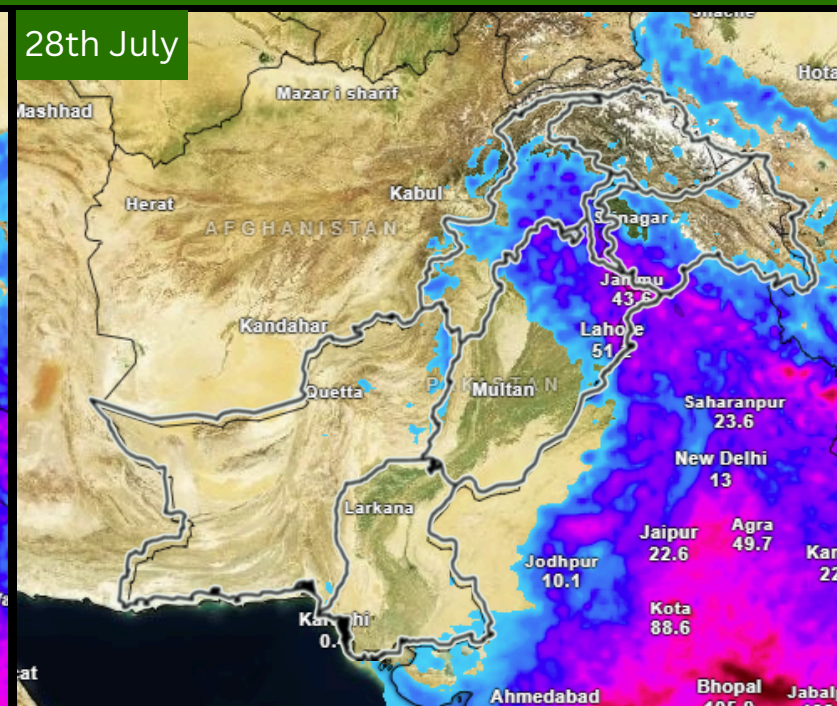
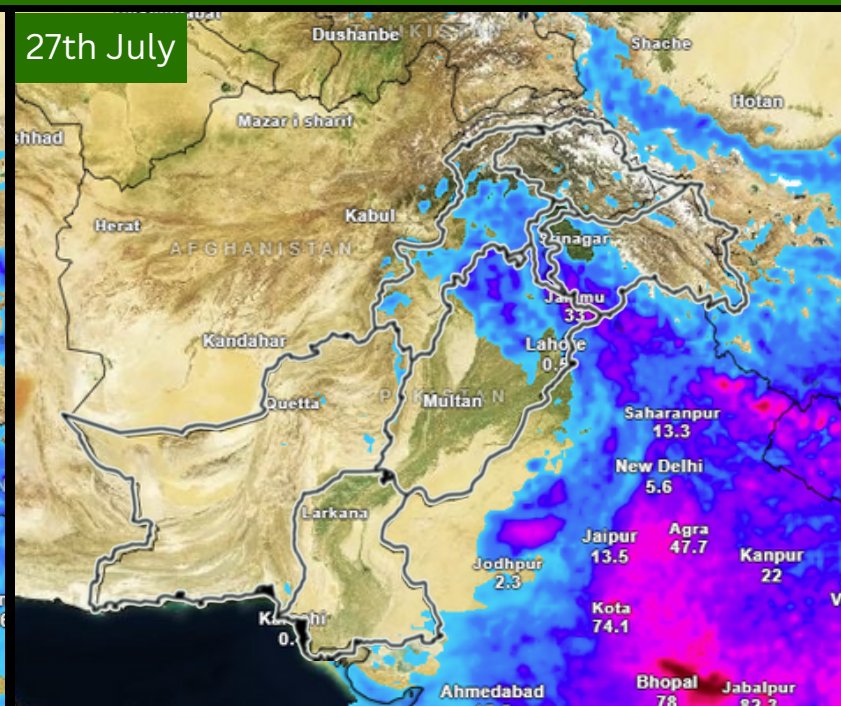
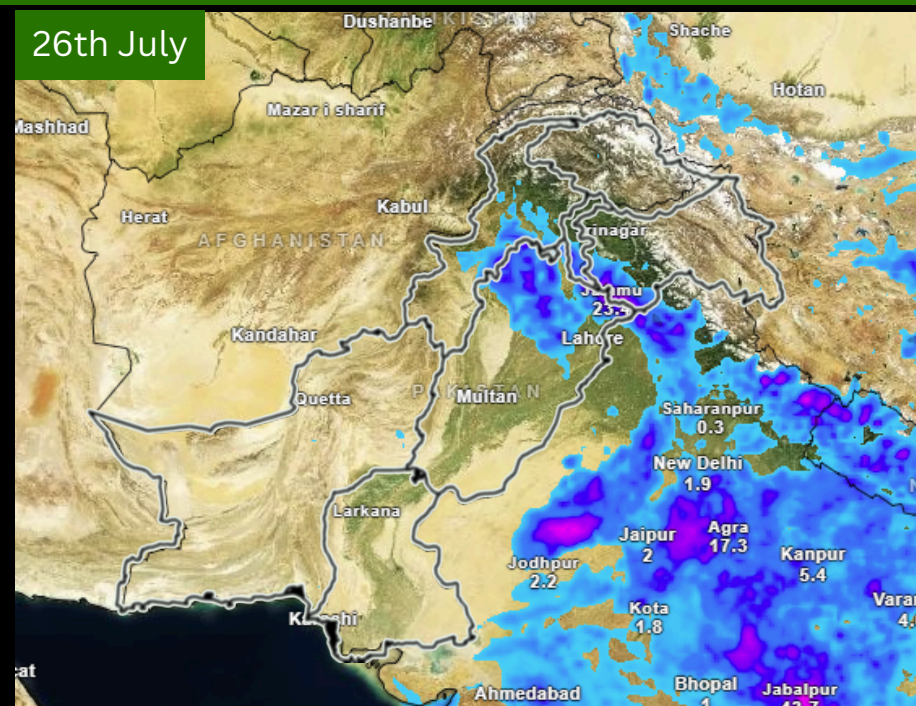




NDMA Met Projections (26th July to 31st July, 2024)



Monsoon currents are entering Pakistan and will impact the upper and central regions of the country.

Punjab:

Thunderstorms and isolated rainfall/ heavyfalls are expected intermittently during 26th to 31st July in the northern and northeastern parts of the province, including Potohar region, Jhelum, Mianwali, Sargodha, Gujranwala, Faisalabad, Hafizabad, Gujrat, Sheikhupura, Narowal, Lahore, Multan, Bahawalpur, Rahimyar Khan, and adjacent areas.

Balochistan:

Hot and humid weather while windstorms, thunderstorms, and isolated rainfall are expected intermittently in the northern and northeastern parts of the province during 29th to 31st July.

Sindh:

Hot and humid weather while windstorm and isolated heavy rainfall is expected in most parts of the province with occasional gaps during the 29th to 31st July.

KP:

Thunderstorms and isolated rainfall/ heavyfalls are expected intermittently during 26th to 31st July in most parts of the province, including Chitral, Dir, Charbagh, Malakand, Swabi, Mardan, Rustam, Peshawar, Charsadda, Haripur, Mansehra, Abbottabad, and surrounding areas.

GB & AJK:

Cloudy weather along with chances of isolated rainfall and thunderstorms is expected in various parts of the provinces during 30th to 31st July, However mostly parts of Kashmir will experience isolated rainfall/ heavyfalls during 26th to 31st July.
