


PRECIPITATION PROJECTION (JAN 26-31, 2024)

PRECIPITATION ADVISORY

- A westerly wave is anticipated to impact the upper regions of the country from today and may persist until the coming week. Additionally, another westerly wave is forecasted to enter the western parts of the country from 28th January onward.
- Cold and cloudy weather is expected across most areas of the country. However, isolated places in Kashmir, Gilgit-Baltistan, Upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Upper Punjab, and north western Balochistan are likely to experience light to moderate rainfall during this week..

Potential Impacts:

- Anticipate travel disruptions, potential road closures, and the risk of localized landslide incase of heavy rain.
- Be aware of the possibility of power outages due to the impact of rain on power lines and infrastructure.

Precautions:

- · Avoid non-essential travel during heavy rainfall.
- Stay updated on weather and road conditions from official sources.
- · Drive carefully and ensure your vehicle is rain-ready.
- · Dress in waterproof layers to stay dry during rain.
- Report emergencies promptly to local authorities.
