Moist currents from the Arabian Sea and the Bay of Bengal are affecting southern and central regions, impacting most parts of the country.

Balochistan:

Windstorms, thunderstorms, and isolated rainfall are expected intermittently in the northern and northeastern parts of the province this week.

Sindh:

Windstorm and isolated heavy rainfall is expected in most parts of the province with occasional gaps during the whole week.

Punjab:

Thunderstorms and isolated heavy rainfall are expected intermittently this week in the upper parts of the province, including Potohar region, Jhelum, Mianwali, Sargodha, Gujranwala, Faisalabad, Hafizabad, Gujrat, Sheikhpura, Narowal, Lahore, Multan, Bahawalpur, Rahimyar Khan, and adjacent areas.

KP:

Thunderstorms and isolated heavy rainfall are expected intermittently this week in most parts of the province, including Chitral, Dir, Charbagh, Malakand, Swabi, Mardan, Rustam, Peshawar, Charsadda, Haripur, Mansehra, Abbottabad, and surrounding areas.

GB & AJK:

Cloudy weather with chances of isolated rainfall and thunderstorms is expected in various parts of the provinces this week, while certain areas of Kashmir will experience isolated heavy rain.
