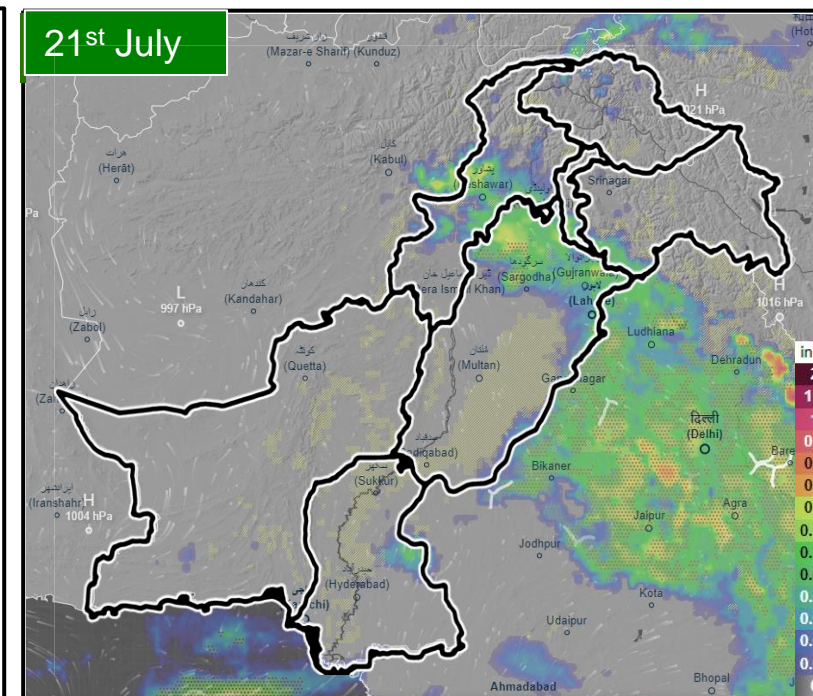
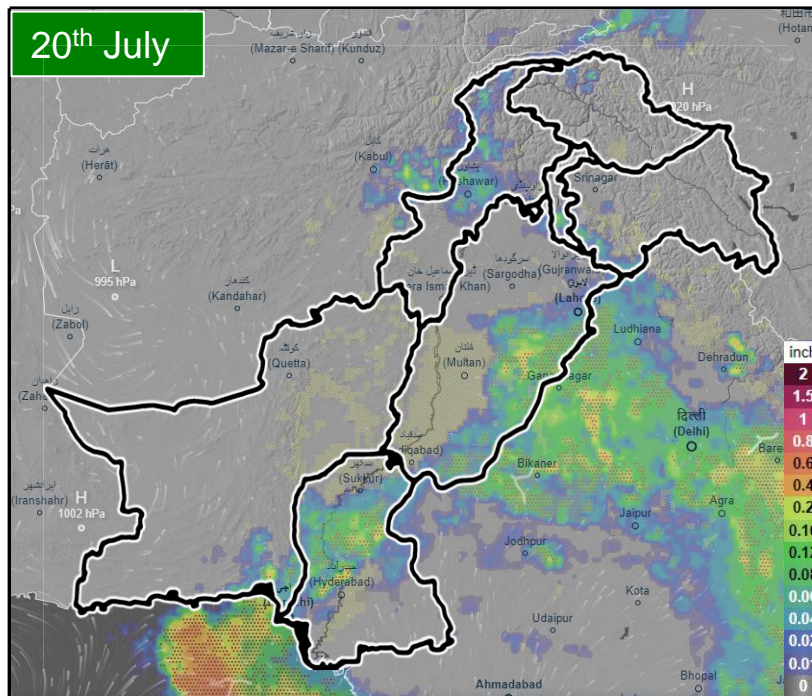
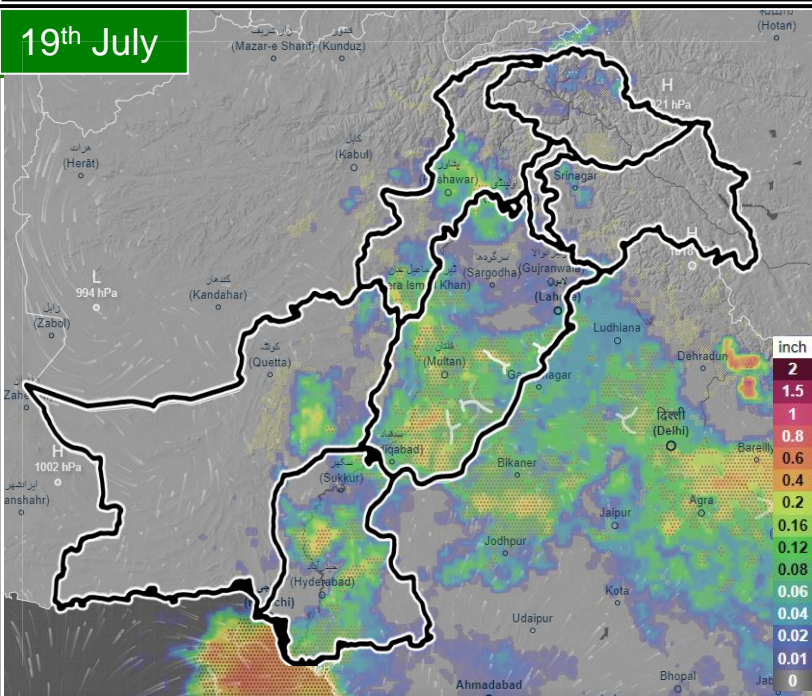
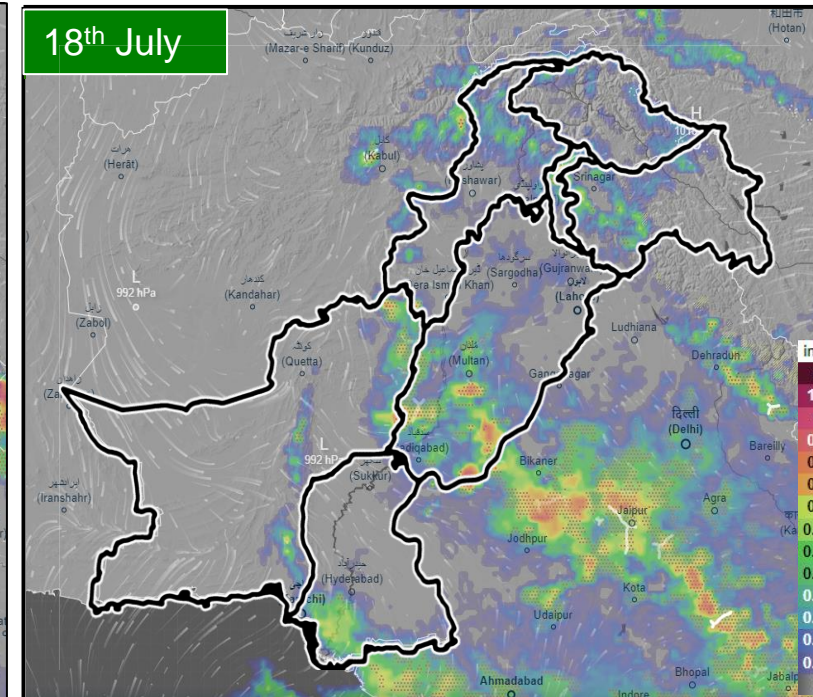
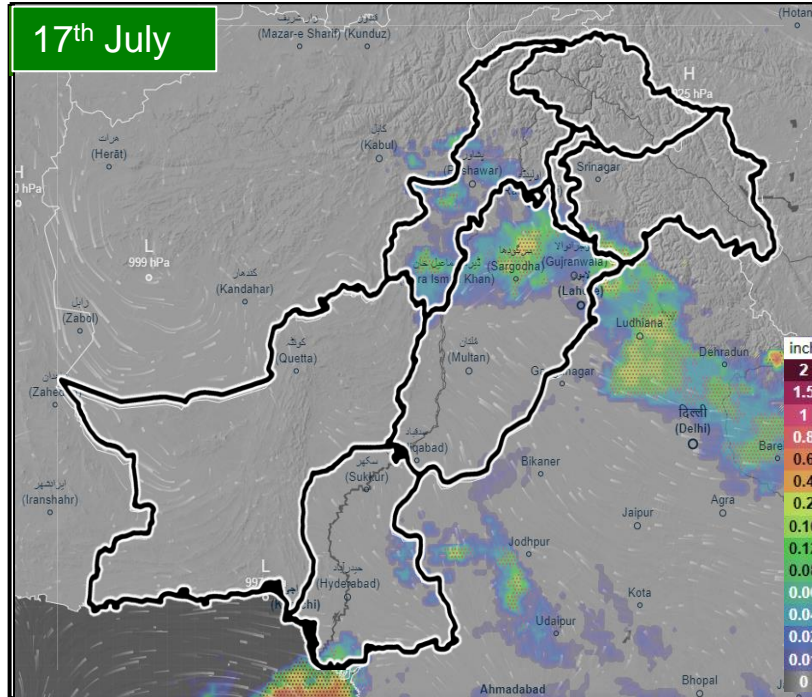
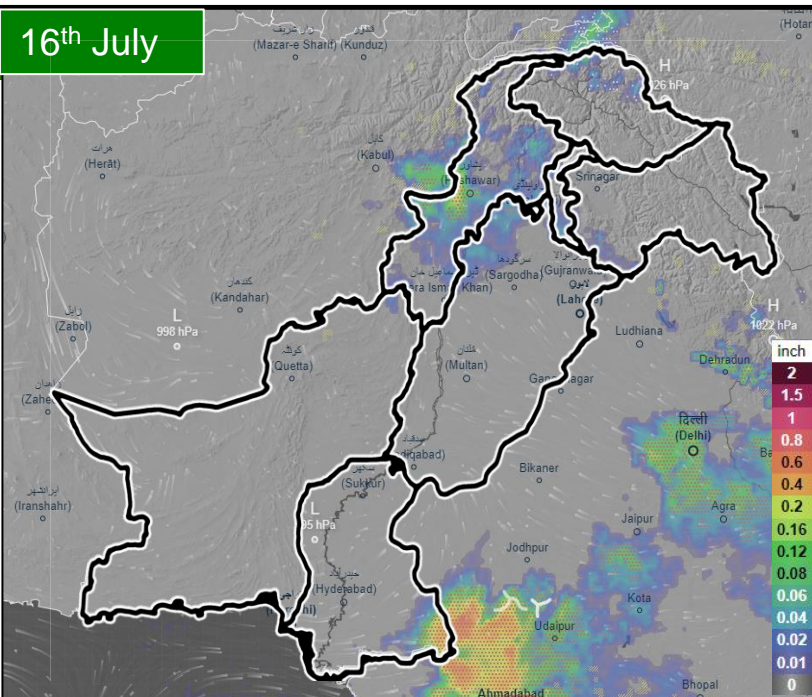




Weather Projection (16th to 21st July 2024)

Monsoon currents from the Arabian Sea are influencing the central parts of the country, while a westerly trough is influencing the upper regions

Balochistan:

Most districts of the province are expected to experience hot and humid weather. However, some areas in the northeast Balochistan may see partly cloudy weather with rain, wind, and thundershowers from July 18 to 19 July.

Sindh:

Mainly hot and humid weather is expected in Sindh with rain-wind/thundershower expected at isolated places in the south.

Punjab:

Rain-wind/thundershower expected in the Pothohar region, upper/central/southern/eastern Punjab.

KP:

Partly cloudy with Rain wind/thundershower is expected at isolated places across the province.

GB and AJ&K:

GB is likely to get scattered showers and thunderstorms, with cloudy weather in upper regions. Isolated showers and thunderstorms, with cloudy weather is expected in Azad Jammu and Kashmir's upper areas.
