NDMA Conducted National SimEx - 1 / 2025 'Summer Resilience' 26-02-2025



National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) successfully conducted National Simulation Exercise (SimEx) - 1 / 2025 titled “Summer Resilience” on February 26, 2025. This exercise focused on tackling four major summer hazards: Cyclones, Heatwaves, Forest Fires & Sea Water Intrusion .

This large-scale simulation brought together key stakeholders, including representatives from Federal Ministries, Provincial Disaster Management Authorities (PDMAs), Armed Forces, Humanitarian Agencies, Media and Academia –all working under a structured framework of exercise controls.

Through scenario-based decision-making, inter-agency coordination and strategic planning, the exercise reinforced NDMA's proactive disaster management to mitigate multiple disasters. This initiative played a crucial role in improving national contingency plans and disaster management strategies, ultimately ensuring better national preparedness in face of emergencies and climate-related hazards.

The exercise aimed to develop a comprehensive and adaptive response strategy for disaster contingencies by thoroughly assessing needs, mutual capacities, and integrating the latest technologies along with innovative humanitarian intervention methods.

The focus was on creating a replicable model that could be applied regionally to ensure effective and coordinated disaster management. Two hypothetical scenarios, a cyclone and a forest fire, were simulated to assess preparedness and response mechanisms.

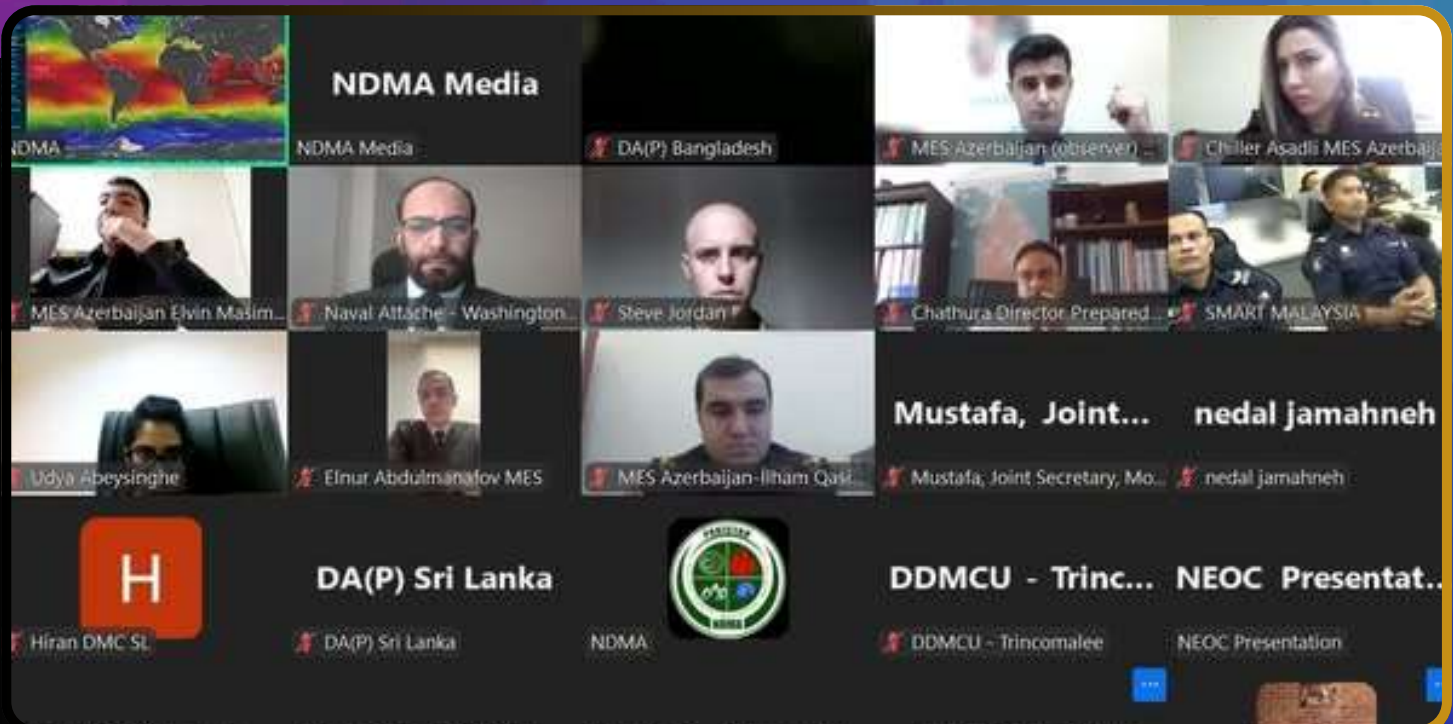


The exercise brought together representatives from lead disaster management agencies across multiple nations, including USA, France, Malaysia, Azerbaijan, Sri Lanka, Jordan, Maldives, Mauritius, and Bangladesh, fostering collaboration and knowledge exchange .

In conclusion, the exercise successfully highlighted the importance of cross-border cooperation and the need for an agile, technology-driven approach to disaster management . It reinforced the critical role of preparedness in saving lives and minimizing damage. The strategies and models will serve as invaluable tools for future regional disaster response initiatives.

NDMA Coordinated to Dispatch 12th Relief Consignment for People of Palestine (Gaza) & overall 23rd Consignment for Middle East 09-02-2025



As per the directives of Prime Minister, Pak NDMA continues the provision of aid to Gaza, Lebanon and Syria.

The 23rd relief consignment has been dispatched from Jinnah International Airport, Karachi. A total of 50 tons of relief goods, including canned meat, powdered milk, blankets, clothing, tents, and warm bedding, have been sent to Palestine.

NDMA has so far dispatched a total of 1,803 tons of relief aid to Lebanon, Gaza, and Syria. The Government of Pakistan continues to send relief items in accordance with the needs of the war-affected people of Lebanon, Palestine, and Syria.

NDMA Coordinated to Dispatch 13th Relief Consignment for People of Palestine (Gaza) & overall 24th Consignment for Middle East 15-02-2025



Under the directives of the Prime Minister of Pakistan, the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) continues to provide humanitarian aid to the war-affected people of Palestine (Gaza), Lebanon, and Syria.

In collaboration with Alkhidmat Foundation, NDMA has dispatched a 60-ton relief consignment to Palestine, consisting of tents, tarpaulins, and warm shelters. The relief goods will be transported by air from Jinnah International Airport, Karachi, to Al-Arish Airport, Syria. Representatives from NDMA, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and Alkhidmat Foundation attended the send-off ceremony.

Under the Prime Minister's directives, a total of 24 relief consignments have been dispatched, amounting to 1,861 tons of aid, including: 1,378 tons for Palestine, 372 tons for Lebanon, 111 tons for Syria.

The Government of Pakistan remains committed to sending aid according to the needs of the war-affected people of Lebanon, Palestine, and Syria.

The 14th relief consignment for Gaza has been dispatched from Jinnah International Airport, Karachi. A total of 100 tons of relief goods, including tents, tarpaulins, warm shelters, and medical supplies, has been sent to Palestine.

NDMA has so far dispatched 1,961 tons of relief aid through 25 consignments. The Government of Pakistan remains committed to providing aid according to the needs of the war-affected people of Palestine 🇵🇸 and the Middle East

Project Collaboration – ‘Disaster Response System for Belt and Road (DRS4BR)’ The Central South University and University of the Punjab will jointly develop a Satellite Emergency-Response System for major natural hazards along the One Belt, One Road (OBOR) initiative.

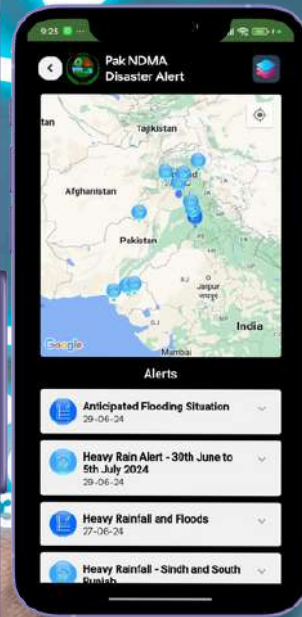
