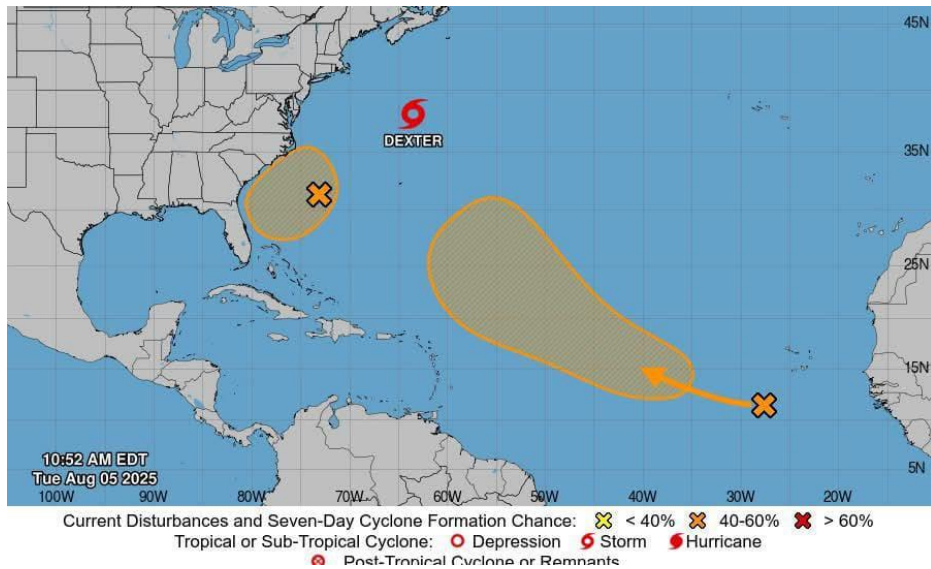

Hazard Summary

Tropical Storm Dexter continues to move over the northwestern Atlantic Ocean and poses no immediate threat to land. Off the southeastern United States, a weak surface trough is expected to develop into a low-pressure system within the next day or so. Conditions could support gradual development, with a 10% chance of formation in the next 48 hours and a 40% chance through the weekend as the system moves westward, then turns north. Meanwhile, in the central tropical Atlantic, a tropical wave is producing scattered thunderstorms. This system may slowly organize, with a tropical depression possibly forming by late this week or weekend, holding a 50% chance of development in the next seven days.
