



Hazard Types

Very Dense Fog: Visibility expected to drop significantly, causing severe disruption to transport, aviation, and daily activities.

Hazard Summary

Dense to Very Dense Fog is most likely to occur at isolated places over Shahdara, Lahore, South Punjab, lower Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, North Sindh in Pakistan, and Faridkot, Fatehgarh Sahib, Fazilka, Ferozepur, Gurdaspur, Hoshiarpur, Moga, Pathankot, Rupnagar. This will severely reduce visibility, impacting road safety, aviation, and railway schedules. The conditions may also pose risks to public health and increase challenges for emergency services and the power sector.
