

Affected Areas

India: Amritsar, Barnala, Bathinda, Jalandhar, Kapurthala, Ludhiana, Malerkotla, Mansa, Patiala, Haryana: Ambala, Fatehabad, Hisar, Jind, Karnal, Kurukshetra,

Hazard Types

Very Dense Fog: Visibility expected to drop significantly, causing severe disruption to transport, aviation, and daily activities.

Hazard Summary

Dense to very dense fog conditions are very likely to persist across parts of Punjab, upper Sindh and lower Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in Pakistan, as well as Haryana-Chandigarh, and Uttar Pradesh in India. This will severely reduce visibility, impacting road safety, aviation, and railway schedules. The conditions may also pose risks to public health and increase challenges for emergency services and the power sector.
