Hazard Summary

An 8.8 magnitude earthquake off Russia's Far East has triggered a Pacific-wide tsunami. In Hawaii, waves up to 5 feet have been reported, and evacuations have been ordered—residents should move to higher ground immediately. Along the coasts of California, Oregon, and Washington, tsunami waves up to 1.6 feet have been observed, with strong currents expected for several hours. Major evacuations are underway in Japan and Russia, where flooding has been reported. The South Pacific regions, including Papua New Guinea, Solomon Islands, and Vanuatu, are also facing an imminent threat according to NOAA.

Make sure your emergency supplies such as water, food, medications, and important documents are ready. Continue to follow updates and instructions from local officials closely to stay safe.
