

Hazard Summary

An extreme precipitation event is impacting Bangladesh, with heavy to very heavy rainfall observed over central and southern regions, including Dhaka, Chandpur, Noakhali, and Nangalkot. Currently a deep depression is approaching the coastal delta of Bangladesh and has tendency to become a cyclonic system, causing intense moisture inflow and convection. The resulting rainfall poses serious risks of urban flooding, flash floods, and riverine inundation. Coastal and low-lying areas are particularly vulnerable. Authorities and the public are urged to take immediate precautions, avoid non-essential travel, and follow updates from the Bangladesh Meteorological Department.
