g.	Gilgit Baltistan	 District Ghanche. Flash Flooding in Thoqmus Nullah (Chorbat) at 1645 hours Baily Bridge washed away & road access to Shyok Sector totally cut off. Site survey is in process. 20 x Shops & 2 x Houses damaged. 3 x Private Vehicles damaged. AC Chorbat evacuated 10 x residents to safe location DDMA has moved excavator & tractor blade to the area for rehab work. GBDMA provided 10 x Tents, 20 x Plastic Mats, 10 x Tarpaulins, 10 x Blankets and 10 x Food Packs to the affectees. DDMA visited Ghursay Village to monitor the situation.& provided 10 x Tents, 4 x Tarpaulin and 160 x Sandbags to the affectees. District Skardu KKH near JSR has been damaged due to high flows in River Indus and Batura Lake. Diversion of traffic has been undertaken at JSR. Repair team mobilised to restore KKH. District Gilgit Due to high flows in River Gilgit, water entered into 2 x Houses near KIU Bridge. Foodpacks has been provided to the affectees. Bagrote Road has been cut off due to high flow in Bagrote Nullah. KKH near Sassi has also been damaged. Restoration work is in progress. District Diamer Road washed away from cadet college to Raikot bridge. KKH blocked at multiple points near Tattapani due to flash flooding as under: RD 466+000 - Two Way Blocked

- 7. <u>Weather Forecast for Next 24 Hours by PMD</u>. Scattered thunderstorm/rain of Moderate Intensity is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Peshawar, Kohat, Banu, DI khan, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha & Bahawalpur Divisions. Isolated thunderstorm/rain is expected over Lahore, Faisalabad, Sahiwal, Multan & DG Khan Divisions.
- 8. Rainfall Last 24 Hours. Attached as Annex C.
- 9. <u>Weather Advisory / Press Release</u>. In response to PMD weather alert NDMA has issued weather advisory to all concerned on 30th July 2021 that monsoon currents are continuously penetrating in upper parts of the country and likely to continue till Tuesday. Under the influence of this weather system, following is predicted:
 - a. Rain-wind-thundershower (with isolated heavy falls) is expected in Kashmir, Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Gujrat, Mandi Bahauddin, Sialkot, Narowal, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Lahore, Faisalabad, Sargodha, Mianwali, Kohistan, Shangla, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Mardan, Charsadda, Nowshera,

- Dir, Chitral, Peshawar, Kohat, Tank and Karak with occasional gaps from Saturday to Tuesday.
- b. Rain-wind-thundershower s expected in Gilgit-Baltistan (Ghizer, Astore, Diamir, Skardu, Gilgit, Hunza, Nagar, Ghanche and Kharmang), Bannu, D.I. Khan, Bhakkar, Layyah, Dera Ghazi Khan, Multan and Sahiwal during the period.
- 10. <u>Flood Warning / Alert</u>. As per FFD, flows are likely to increase in River Jhelum at upstream Mangla (High to Very High flood level) and High flood in River Chenab at Marala, Khanki, Qadirabad from 28th to 30th July 2021.
