#### SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST: I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST:

River Indus at Guddu & Sukkur is in medium flood level. River Ravi at Sidhnai and River Sutlej at Sulemanki & Islam are in Low flood level.

#### **II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:**

- a. Yesterday's Depression over North Chattisgarh has moved slightly Westwards and today lies over Northeast Madhya Paradesh as monsoon low.
- b. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Northeast Afghanistan continues to persist.
- c. Light to moderate moist currents from Arabian Sea are penetrating to upper parts of the country up to 5000 feet.
- d. Seasonal low lies over North Balochistan.

#### **III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:**

Scattered wind thunderstorm/ rain of light to moderate intensity with isolated heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers, Islamabad along with Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, DI Khan,
