SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST:

River Indus at Guddu and Sukkur and River Sutlej at Sulemanki & Islam are in Low flood level.

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

- a. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Northern parts of the country has moved away Eastwards.
- b. Light moist currents from Arabian Sea are penetrating to upper parts of the country up to 4000 feet.
- c. Seasonal low lies over North Balochistan.

III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Thunderstorm rain of light to moderate intensity at isolated places is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers, Islamabad along with Peshawar, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha, Lahore & DG Khan Divisions.
