SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST:

River Indus at Guddu & Sukkur is in Medium flood level. River Indus at Taunsa, River Ravi at Sidhnai and River Sutlej at Sulemanki & Islam are in Low flood level.

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

- a. A well marked monsoon low has developed over Northeast Bay of Bengal.
- b. A fresh trough of westerly wave lies over Northern parts of Afghanistan.
- c. Mild moist currents from Arabian Sea are penetrating to upper parts of the country up to 3000 feet.
- d. Seasonal low lies over North Balochistan.

III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Mainly dry weather is expected over most parts of the country, however isolated wind thunderstorm/rain of light to moderate intensity is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers, Northeast Balochistan, Islamabad along with DIKhan ,Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha, Lahore & DGKhan Divisions.

IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NEXT 48-HOURS:

Rainfall activity is likely to increase slightly over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with North & Northeast Punjab.
