I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST:

River Indus at Taunsa, Guddu & Kotri is in Low flood level.

#### **II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:**

- a. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Northern parts of Afghanistan persists.
- b. Light to Moderate moist currents from Arabian Sea are penetrating to upper parts of the country up to 5000 feet.
