SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST:

River Indus at Tarbela & Guddu is in Low flood level. Low to Medium level flooding is expected in Nullahs of Rivers Ravi and Chenab. According to the information available, Reservoirs in India at Sutlej and Beas Rivers are near to attain maximum levels (Bhakra 6 feet below and Pong 4.5 feet below). In the presence of current meteorological situation, moderate to heavy rainfall is expected over the upper catchments of Rivers Sutlej and Beas. Flows at GS Wala and downstream are likely to increase (subject to releases from India).

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

- a. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over North of the country (Pakistan), today lies over Northern parts of the country (Pakistan).
- Moderate moist currents from Arabian Sea are penetrating to upper parts of the country, up to 5000 feet. b.
- Well-marked Seasonal low lies over Northeast Balochistan.

III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Scattered to widespread thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity with isolated heavy falls associated with gusty wind is expected over the upper catchments of Rivers Sutlej, Ravi &

Chenab along with Islamabad and Rawalpindi, Sargodha, Gujranwala & Lahore Divisions. Scattered wind thunderstorm rain of moderate intensity with isolated heavy falls is also expected over the upper catchments of Rivers Indus, Kabul & Jhelum along with Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu,

D.I Khan, Sahiwal & Faisalabad Divisions.

IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NEXT 48-HOURS:

Wet-spell is likely to decrease.
