#### SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST:

River Indus at Tarbela, Chashma, Guddu & Kotri and River Sutlej at Islam are in Low flood level.

#### **II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:**

- a. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over North of the country has moved away Eastwards and a fresh trough of westerly wave lies over Northern parts of Afghanistan.
- b. Mild moist currents from Arabian Sea are penetrating to upper parts of the country up to 5000 feet.
- c. Seasonal low lies over North Balochistan.

#### **III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:**
