 - a. 5x deaths in District Gujrat & 1x death in District Bhakkar due to wall / building collapsed.
 - b. 3x deaths in District Layyah. 2x deaths in District Okara, 1x death in District Muzaffargarh & 1x death in District Sialkot due to drowning.
- **2.** <u>Balochistan</u>. On 3 July 2021, 1x death was reported in Kingri, District Musakhel due to drowning.
