- 7. Weather Forecast for Next 24 Hours by PMD. Scattered to fairly wide-spread thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity with isolated heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Rawalpindi, Sargodha Gujranwala & Lahore Divisions. Isolated thunderstorm/ rain is expected over Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, DI Khan, Faisalabad, Sahiwal, Multan, DG Khan & Bahawalpur Divisions along with East Balochistan and Southeast Sindh.
- 8. Rainfall Last 24 Hours. Attached as Annex B.
- 9. <u>Weather Advisory / Press Release</u>. In response to PMD weather alert NDMA has issued weather advisory to all concerned on 8<sup>th</sup> July 2021 that strong monsoon currents are likely to penetrate northeastern parts of the country from weekend. Under the influence of this weather system, following is predicted:
  - a. Rain-wind-thundershower (with few heavy falls at time) is expected in Kashmir, Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Gujrat, Mandi Bahauddin, Sialkot, Narowal, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Lahore, Sheikhupura,

- Kasur, Okara, Faisalabad, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Sargodha, Mianwali, Khushab, Bhakkar and Layyah from 10<sup>th</sup> July 2021 (evening/night) to 14<sup>th</sup> July 2021.
- b. Rain-wind-thundershowers (with few heavy falls at time) is expected in Dir, Swat, Buner, Kohistan, Shangla, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Mardan, Swabi, Charsadda, Nowshera, Peshawar, Waziristan, Kurrum, Bannu, Kohat, Lakki Marwat, Tank, Karak and Dera Ismail Khan, Gilgit-Baltistan (Ghizer, Astore, Diamer, Skardu, Gilgit, Hunza Nagar, Ghanche and Kharmang) from 11<sup>th</sup> July 2021 (evening/night) to 14<sup>th</sup> July 2021.
- c. Rain/wind-thundershower (with isolated heavy falls) is expected in Dera Ghazi Khan, Rajanpur, Multan, Khanewal, Sahiwal, Bahawalnagar, Bahawalpur and Rahim Yar Khan, Sibbi, Kohlu, Loralai, Barkhan, Sukkar, Jaccobabad, Tharparker, Sanghar and Mirpurkhas from 12<sup>th</sup> July 2021 (evening/night) to 14<sup>th</sup> July 2021.

#### 10. Flood Warning / Alert.

- a. There is a likelihood of urban flooding due to heavy rains in Rawalpindi, Lahore, Gujranwala, Peshawar and Faisalabad on 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> July 2020.
- Heavy rains may generate flash flooding and may trigger landslides in vulnerable areas of Kashmir, Gilgit Baltistan, Punjab and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa from 12<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> July 2021.
