- 5. Weather Forecast for Next 24 Hours by PMD. Scattered thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity with heavy falls at isolated places is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Southeast Sindh and Rawalpindi, Gujranwala & D.G. Khan Divisions. Scattered Thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity is also expected over Balochistan, rest of Sindh along with Peshawar, DIKhan, Sargodha, Lahore, Faisalabad, Sahiwal & Multan Divisions. Isolated thunderstorm/rain is also expected in Bahawalpur Division.
- 6. Rainfall Last 24 Hours. Attached as Annex B
- 7. <u>Weather Advisory / Press Release.</u> In response to PMD Weather Forecast, NDMA has issued weather advisory to all concerned on 5th July 2022, that monsoon currents are penetrating in the country and may continue during next 24 48 hrs. As a result of this, the expected weather will be as under:
 - a. <u>Islamabad</u> Rain-windstorm/thundershower is expected from Tuesday 05th July (night) to Thursday 07th July (morning).
 - b. Balochistan Rain-windstorm/thundershower (Isolated heavy falls) are expected in Zhob, Ziarat, Barkhan, Loralai, Kohlu, Quetta, Kalat, Khuzdar, Lasbella, Naseerabad, Sibbi, Panjgur, Turbat, Pasni, Gwadar, Ormara, Kech, Awaran, and Kharan from Tuesday 05th July (night) to Thursday 07th July.
 - c. <u>Khyber Pakhtunkhwa</u> Rain-windstorm/thundershower are expected in Swat, Mansehra, Kohistan, Abbottabad, Haripur, Peshawar, Mardan, Swabi and Nowshera Tuesday 05th July (night) to Thursday 07th July (morning).
 - d. <u>Punjab</u> Rain-windstorm/thundershower are expected in Rawalpindi, Murree, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Sargodha, Hafizabad, M. B Din, Sialkot, Narowal, Mianwali, Bhakkar, Lahore, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Sheikhupura, Faisalabad, Jhang, T.T Singh, Okara, Tuesday 05th July (night) to Thursday 07th July (morning).
 - e. <u>Sindh</u> Rain-windstorm/thundershower (Isolated heavy falls) are expected in Mirpurkhas, Dadu, Karachi, Thatta, and Badin from Tuesday 05th July (night) to 07 July.
 - f. <u>Azad Jammu & Kashmir</u> Rain-windstorm/thundershower (Isolated heavy falls) are expected in Kashmir from Tuesday 05th July (night) to Thursday 07th July (morning).

- 8. <u>Flood Warning / Alert</u>. Heavy falls may generate urban flooding in Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Lahore, Gujranwala, Sialkot, and Faisalabad from 2nd to 4th July & in Karachi and Hyderabad from 3rd to 5th July. Likewise, Heavy rain falls may generate flash flooding in local Nullahs/Rivers of Barkhan, Zhob, Sibbi, Panjgur, Kohlu, Naseerabad, Nagarparkar and Dadu. Similarly, Heavy downpour of water may cause urban flooding in Karachi, Hyderabad, Thatta, Badin, Khuzdar, Ormara, Pasni and Gawadar during the forecast period.
