c. Relief Activities

- (1) GBDMA & DDMA Ghizer have dispatched 30x winterized tents, 40x normal tents, 30x plastic matts, 3x portable washrooms, 80x sleeping bags, 50x mattresses, 50x blankets, 100x food packs for the affectees of Sherqilla, District Ghizer.
- (2) Efforts by the maintenance staff to remove heavy boulders for opening of Juglot Skardu Road (JSR) is in progress.

d. Relief Camps Established. NTR

e. Rescue Activities.

- (1) Diversion of Nullah away from Sherqilla, District Ghizer Settlement was completed early morning today. Steps being taken to stop seepage of water through boulders. Dead body of 1x female drowned on 5th July, have been recovered by Local volunteers and Rescue 1122 in Sherqilla, District Ghizer.
- (2) DDMA staff is working in District Ghanche to remove heavy boulders from the blocked road.
- (3) District Administration along with Rescue 1122 team safely rescued 15x person stuck in River Tochi near Banda Bridge Miranshah, North Waziristan.
- (4) An emergency imposed in District Quetta to prevent casualties from flood like situation.
- (5) Rescue teams are in search of missing female dead body in District Mansehra.

- 5. Weather Forecast for Next 24 Hours by PMD. Fairly wide spread thunderstorm/rain with heavy falls at scattered places and very heavy falls at isolated places is expected over Gujranwala & Lahore Divisions along with Balochistan. Scattered to Fairly widespread thunderstorm/rain with isolated heavy falls is also expected over all the Major Rivers along with Sindh, Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu D.I.Khan, Rawalpindi, Sargodha, Faisalabad, Multan & D.G.Khan Divisions. Isolated thunderstorm/rain is expected over Sahiwal & Bahawalpur Division.

- 7. <u>Weather Advisory / Press Release.</u> In response to PMD Weather Forecast, NDMA has issued weather advisory to all concerned on 5th July 2022, that monsoon currents are penetrating in the country and may continue during next 24 48 hrs. As a result of this, the expected weather will be as under:
 - a. <u>Islamabad</u> Rain-windstorm/thundershower is expected from Tuesday 05th July (night) to Thursday 07th July (morning).
 - b. <u>Balochistan</u> Rain-windstorm/thundershower (Isolated heavy falls) are expected in Zhob, Ziarat, Barkhan, Loralai, Kohlu, Quetta, Kalat, Khuzdar, Lasbella, Naseerabad, Sibbi, Panjgur, Turbat, Pasni, Gwadar, Ormara, Kech, Awaran, and Kharan from Tuesday 05th July (night) to Thursday 07th July.
 - c. <u>Khyber Pakhtunkhwa</u> Rain-windstorm/thundershower are expected in Swat, Mansehra, Kohistan, Abbottabad, Haripur, Peshawar, Mardan, Swabi and Nowshera Tuesday 05th July (night) to Thursday 07th July (morning).
 - d. <u>Punjab</u> Rain-windstorm/thundershower are expected in Rawalpindi, Murree, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Sargodha, Hafizabad, M. B Din, Sialkot, Narowal, Mianwali, Bhakkar, Lahore, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Sheikhupura, Faisalabad, Jhang, T.T Singh, Okara, Tuesday 05th July (night) to Thursday 07th July (morning).
 - e. <u>Sindh</u> Rain-windstorm/thundershower (Isolated heavy falls) are expected in Mirpurkhas, Dadu, Karachi, Thatta, and Badin from Tuesday 05th July (night) to 07 July.

- f. **Azad Jammu & Kashmir** Rain-windstorm/thundershower (Isolated heavy falls) are expected in Kashmir from Tuesday 05th July (night) to Thursday 07th July (morning).
- 8. <u>Flood Warning / Alert</u>. No Flood Situation is observed in any of the Major Rivers. Flash food situation is expected in the Rivers/Nullahs of Balochistan during next 48- hours. Medium to high level floods is expected in Nullahs of Rivers Ravi and Chenab during 6th to 7th June 2022.
