- c. <u>Relief Activities</u>. 250x food packs and 200x plastics mats provided to Killa Saifullah and 250x food packs were provided to district Washuk. 3000x food packs (95 Kg each) has been provided by NDMA/ KS-RELIEF at districts Quetta, Lasbella, Khuzdar, Pishin, Killa Abdullah and Killa Saifullah (500x food packs at each district). 3000x food packs are being provided to GB and Balochistan (1500x food packs each) by NDMA/ KORT.
- d. <u>Relief Camps Established</u>. PDMA Balochistan established camps for IDPs, provided facilities of Tents, Medical facilities, Clean Drinking Water, Grayscale Water, Washrooms, Janitorial services, food and other non-food items. A small school / Madrasa is also established for children in District Killa Saifullah.
- e. <u>Rehabilitation Activities</u>. On 14th July 2022, Mach City link bridge got damaged. Through alternate route traffic opened for Mach City and rehabilitation work for bridge is under process.
- f. Rescue Activities. PDMA Balochistan Rescue team dispatched for search and rescue operation at Khanani area, district Pishin.
