SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST: I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST:

River Sutlej at Sulemanki is in Low Flood Level and is falling, while all the other Major Rivers are flowing below low flood level.

- II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:
- a. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Northern parts of the country has moved away Eastwards. A fresh trough of westerly wave lies over Northern parts of Iran.
- b. Yesterday's monsoon low over North Bay of Bengal, today lies over West Jharkhand(India) and adjoining areas.
- c. Light to Moderate Moist currents from Arabian sea and Bay of Bengal are penetrating to upper parts of the country up to 5000 feet.
- d. Seasonal low lies over North Balochistan.
- III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Scattered wind thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Islamabad and Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, D.I Khan, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha, Lahore, Faisalabad, Multan, Sahiwal, D.G Khan & Bahawalpur Divisions. Isolated wind thunderstorm/rain is also expected over Zhob, Loralai, Sibbi, Nasirabad & Kalat Divisions. IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NEXT 48-HOURS:
