#### SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST: 1: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST:

Rivers Indus at Tarbela, Kalabagh & Chashma, River Kabul at Nowshera and River Chenab at Marala are in low flood level. Medium to High level flood is expected in Rivers Chenab & Jhelum (upstream Mangla) along with associated Nullahs of Rivers Ravi & Chenab during next 48-hours.

#### II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

- a. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Northern parts of Afghanistan today lies over Northern parts of the country.
- b. Yesterday's monsoon low over Northwest Bay of Bengal moved westwards and today lies over Southwest Chattisgarh.
- c. Strong moist currents from Bay of Bengal and mild moist current from Arabian sea are penetrating to upper parts of the country up to 7000. This condition is likely to continue.
- d. Weak Seasonal low lies over Balochistan.
- III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Scattered to widespread wind thunderstorm/rain of moderate to heavy intensity with isolated very heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of Rivers Sutlej, Ravi & Chenab along with Lahore, Gujranwala and Southern parts of Kalat Division. Scattered to widespread wind thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity with isolated heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of Rivers Indus, Jhelum, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, rest of Punjab, Sindh along with Zhob, Loralai, Sibbi and Nasirabad Divisions.
