SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST:

River Sutlej at Ganda Singh Wala & Sulemanki is in Low Flood Level and falling, while all the other Major Rivers are flowing below low flood level.

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

- Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Northern parts of Afghanistan today lies over Northeast Afghanistan.
- Moderate Moist currents from Arabian sea are penetrating to upper parts of the country up to 5000 feet. It is likely to Strengthen.
- c. Well-Marked Seasonal low lies over North Balochistan and its trough is extending Northwards.

III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Scattered wind thunderstorm/ rain of light to moderate intensity with Isolated heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Islamabad and Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, DI Khan, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha, Lahore, Faisalabad, Multan, Sahiwal, DG Khan & Bahawalpur Divisions. Isolated wind thunderstorm/rain is also expected over Northeast Balochistan.

IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NEXT 48-HOURS:

Scattered to widespread wind thunderstorm/ rain of light to moderate intensity with Isolated heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Islamabad and Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, DI Khan, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha, Lahore, Faisalabad, Multan, Sahiwal, DG Khan & Bahawalpur Divisions. Isolated wind thunderstorm/rain is also expected over Northeast Balochistan.


